Coopys - Reviewer Sgt Thomas

This is a tipping service run by a professional tipster; the website contains the life story of this particular gentleman and not much in a way of a sales pitch. So with no reference to past performance or what you might expect to make if you join the service this will be a short introduction. The idea behind the service is to find "Value Bets" i.e. bets which are at higher prices than they should be how ever there is no explanation on how this is determined. The selections given come with staking advice and whether to bet to win or E.W. Anyway good luck with that one Sgt Thomas, the early results can be seen on the weekly review section of this newsletter.

Form Finder Pro Software - Reviewer Sgt Philip

This is software that rates horses in a race where all runners have OR, TR and RPR ratings available on the Racing Post website. These RP ratings are then converted to another rating which is either a positive or negative one. If any horse in the race does not have a full set of RP figures the race is void the only exception is if that horse is a non runner.

There are many way's to use the software backing, laying, dutching, forecasts and various other ways of making selections. For the purpose of this review Sgt Philip has decide to use Top Ratings, Forecasts and Laying to test the software's ability to make a profit, but due to time constraints he will not be making selections everyday. The good part about this product is that it only costs £7 at the moment, which would be a bargain if it proved to be successful.

Laying Autumn Profits - Reviewer Sgt Tony

As the name applies this system relates to laying horses during the autumn period September 1st to 30th November. The system comes with a short but straightforward manual and an introductory video; it concentrates on laying 2 and 3 year old fillies in flat races (Not NH bumpers). 8 steps are involved to pick selections as per Sgt Tony it should take on average 10 to 20 minutes per day but of course it depends on the number of qualifying races. You should get around 1 to 4 selections per day and you can get 5 years of results and statistics on the Laying Autumn Profits website. How much will it cost you? \$150 or nearest equivalent around £97, an e-mail service is also available that will cost you £97 per month. The system did not get off to a flying start but has since rallied; for more information look in our weekly review updates section.

Soccer Tips Software - Reviewer Sgt Brendan

This is piece of football selecting software comes from the same stable as The Pointer Software and gives you selections in a matter of minutes it covers the UK season from August to May and the Australian season from May to August. The operators recommend allowing at least 6 matches to be played before running the programme. Looking at the website only a couple of team selected were actually playing away so prices would probably be on the restrictive side but to counter that the website claims a 92% success rate. The cost of the software is £39.99 a month although you can currently take 6 months subscription for £97 which works out at £16.16 per month which is considerable saving, but the good news is that you get to try out the software for 14 days before you are billed. Sgt Brendan will be reporting on a weekly basis and to Bet 365 prices.

Final Reviews

Just 1 Final Review this week and that was for Planet Horseracing which was placed in the neutral category.

Passed 5*Highly Recommended

None for the period of September 27th to 3rd October.

Passed! Minimum 84 day Review

None for the period of September 27th to 3rd October.

Released On Bail (Neutral)

Just the one Final Review and that was for Planet Horseracing due to the in-depth nature of the review I have had to copy a fair amount of the original material from the website.

Planet Horseracing - Reviewer Sgt Tony

Planet Horseracing has been an interesting trial in that I have recorded some very different results, depending upon which way we view the system. The authors recommend a number of different staking systems. For the purpose of this review we used level stakes betting at £40.00 per selection (which equals 1 point at level stakes).

The other ‘complication’ is that the selections are given each day with a recommended maximum odds limit for each one. I decided to ignore this for the review, as I thought it might be possible for people to get their bets on during the day within the recommended odds limit, even though the horse’s price might drift beyond that recommended limit before the off. I adopted this rule whether the selection won or lost. This caused a bit of a stir on the review blog as some people claimed it was unfair that I had taken the profit when the Betfair SP was above the recommended odds limit. As usual, they had not read the ‘rules’ and conveniently forgot to mention that it was OK to take losses when the odds went above the recommended limit!

Using the Planet Horseracing method outlined above (ignoring the recommended odds limits) and using a level points staking plan we had two profitable months and one losing month (well, part of a month as the review only went up to 21 September!) but made a loss overall of -£277.20 or -6.93 points at level stakes for the review period. However, if we had taken note of the authors’ advice on the recommended maximum odds limit the loss of -£277.20 (-6.93 points at level stakes) became a profit for the period of £186.80 (4.67 points at level stakes).

So there is the dilemma – how do you rate Planet Horseracing with two conflicting sets of results? My personal opinion, based on the review period, is to give it a positive review, but

under the strict criteria of Betting System Truths the maximum I am allowed to award it is Neutral. Under either method we had two profitable months and one losing month, so that is no bad thing in my book. Added to that is the fact that Planet Horseracing results, proofed to Tip Exchange, have shown consistent profits this year. It has been a very 'up and down' period during the review and the authors are quite peeved that they have not been able to show us the same level of results during the review period that they have achieved since they started. Under the first review method, they suffered from quite a few losing lays that drifted heavily during the day e.g. Kathleen Frances, Epic, Mr Irons, North side Prince. The final Betfair SPs on these alone have cost a total of around 8 to 9 points compared to when the selections were posted. That fact shows just how we get the differences when using the second method. I looked at a few other laying systems over the same period and noticed that a few of them had also experienced some strange results.

As I said in my introduction, the Planet Horseracing service seems to be open and honest and the website contains many other useful sources of information such as their Trading Information, Weekly Blog, Race reviews/replays etc. The trading information is very interesting, because they even recommend and show you ways to trade out of your potential losses (using Geeks Toy, for example) if the price is drifting out.

So taking everything into account this service was awarded 2.5 stars and put into neutral ready for another review in the future.

Bettors Bot

Latest and greatest of the scam production line, this one which is introduced by an American on a video is suppose to use Betfair. So the marketing people of this product show a Wachovia Bank statement the problem with this is no American Bank account would be able to use Betfair so that's a major bloomer. If you look in the images folder for this site you will find 2 screenshots of a Betfair P/L history for the period 2nd August to 9th now one of these shows the p/l for Basketball, Football and Horseracing, now the amount shown for the Horseracing is £1155.36. Now you will see another P/L history screenshot within the images folder with the same date, same account showing Horseracing as having £1642.14 it does not show the other sports you have 2 different amounts for Horseracing, both are impossible, so obviously these are made up. **So it failed the BST 5 point MOT Test you have been warned!**

Scam Alerts

Here is a copy of a posting from a concerned reader on the blog regarding Scott Cotton and Psychic systems:

Scott Colton has got some cheek! He is the Owner of the Psychic brand. BST reviewed Scotts products independently and honestly for longer than they usually review other products and they failed miserably. In my opinion Scott has a massive bee in his bonnet over this. In my opinion Scott has tried to join the betting system review site bandwagon.

In my opinion I believe he is offering many short free trials to his readers and in my opinion it is in the view that hopefully one of them will at least do ok. Like the old saying goes “Throw enough S**t at the wall and eventually some of it will stick”. This in my opinion has been the case recently for Scott. This is when Scott “In my opinion” pounces and charges you a monthly fee. In my opinion Scott seems to have a love affair with BST, an obsession and cannot help himself dropping snide libellous comments about BST in his email broadcasts of which I am a member still ONLY so that I can laugh at his manner....

I remember BST told me via private email that they almost got suckered into helping Scott with his terrible psychic systems (**BSG...This is true, but we have lost the email...**) but had a lucky escape as they thought there was something not quite right about him at the time that they couldn't put their finger on. Unfortunately friends of BST helped Scott and have regretted it ever since. PayPal severely restricting their PayPal account supposedly because of the refund requests! And lack of customer support.

In summary... **“In My Opinion” you should Beware of Scott Colton!**

7 winning days out of 7 for this strategy and a profit of 11.11 points for the period, Sgt Dave had a total of 54 selections of which 44 were winning bets that is a Strike Rate of 81.48%. So a promising start to Betfair ATM with a profit of 20.21 points for the 2 weeks of the review and from 97 selections, 81 were successful this an 83.50% Strike Rate this is inline with the figures quoted on the products website.
