Lunchtime Profit Alerts – Review Summary - Reviewer Sgt Jon





Richie Forbes Lunchtime Profit Alert

Hi Bloggers

Apologies for the lateness of this review summary.

Lunchtime Profit Alerts is a weekly e-mail / mobile text football tips service which is accompanied by a detailed analysis of why the bets are recommended. The service costs £27 for the first YEAR and then renewal subscriptions are £72 per year.

When you join <u>Lunchtime Profit Alerts</u> you receive an e-book of Premiership statistics for every team which I found to be very useful information. You also receive clear explanations of the various soccer bets available and a hard copy newsletter is also delivered by post each month.

Back Everton (+1.0) to beat Manchester City on the Asian Handicap

Bet One: Premiership, Monday 8.00pm, 1 point – Everton (+1.0) to beat Man City on the Asian Handicap at 4/6

This game will be live on Sky Sports 1

Everton have been a tough team to weigh up for form punters. Just when you think they've turned the corner they get turned over by West Brom at Goodison, only to turn that form on its head a week later with a very adept performance against the reigning Premiership champions Chelsea.

As we all know, the scoreline isn't everything in this game. In football the best team doesn't always win and where Everton have been concerned, this season has been yet more of the same old story.

A slow start to the season, playing well but not getting the results their performances have deserved.

This has happened before of course (last season was an almost carbon copy) but in the end, Everton usually arrive at the season's end with a respectable tally of points and a respectable position on the Premier League ladder – and I fancy that will be the case again this season.

Given the circumstances at Man City right now, Everton with a +1 handicap looks by far and away the best bet of the weekend. Man City have scored just one goal in their last FOUR home matches and with the Tevez situation still causing problems behind the scenes, it's hard to envisage Everton getting a real pummelling here.

In fact, Everton getting a road pummelling isn't something that has happened often this season – the only time that Everton have not managed to generate more scoring chances and more shots (total and on target) than their host, was against Tottenham a few weeks ago.

Other than that Everton have actually outperformed the home team and while I'm not banking on that being the case here, I am certainly not expecting the reverse.

A repeat of Everton's performance against Chelsea would be enough to make the Toffees really competitive here and with a +1 Asian Handicap, I've no hesitation at all about striking this bet

Asian Handicap payouts

We win if Everton win.
We win if the match is a draw.
If Everton are beaten by 1 goal we receive our full stake back.

Bet One: Premiership, Monday 8.00pm, 1 point – Everton (+1.0) to beat Man City on the Asian Handicap at 4/6

You then receive an e-mail the following week summarising the result and outcome of the bet:

Premiership, Monday 8.00pm, 1 point – Everton (+1.0) to beat Man City on the Asian Handicap

Result: Everton 2 Man City 1. Bet won.

In our Friday e-mail I said:

"Everton with a +1 handicap looks by far and away the best bet of the weekend."

And they didn't let us down, beating City 2-1. Incidentally, I also mentioned in that mail that City had scored just one goal in their last four home matches going into this and the goal credited to them here was actually an Everton own goal.

Everton were 2-0 up in this game after 19 minutes and on the Asian Handicap, Man City would have needed to score four unanswered goals for us to lose our money.

Regrettably, **I cannot recall a single bet that was available at longer than evens** which means a high strike rate is required to make profit. For the 12 week trial this did not happen with just 15 winning bets from 35 tips resulting in an overall points loss.

Therefore I can only recommend Lunchtime Profit Alerts is placed in the **FAILED** category.

I am now, (among others systems) with The Secret Tipster and realize I don't know what I am doing when it comes to Lay betting. I have multi accounts and considered starting at say £3 a point for a test run. Hopefully you could educate me somewhat and explain about matching Lay bets on Betfair.

I'm not sure if you are asking about backing and laying matched bets or just about Laying in general. The Pro-Tip article below will help you if you want to know about matching bets with both Bookies and on the Exchanges. If you need advice on Laying in general, just ask and I'm sure readers will try to help.

Pro Tips – How to be a "mug punter"

This is the first of an occasional series of "pro-tips". I hope others will contribute their tips over the coming months.

First let me say that I am no pro expert (yet!). I am learning along with most of us, but recently I read some accounts of punters having their Bookie accounts frozen, limited or closed, due to being successful and making a profit.

I put some thought into this, while reviewing the "9 minute system", which uses a clever mathematical model that is designed to make a profit. Basically it uses "matched" bets on a Bookie account and on an Exchange account like Betfair. I applied this to the problem of becoming a successful punter and avoiding being penalised by the Bookie.

This subject was discussed in the comments on our review of All By The Book, which when applied properly would result in some successful Bookie accounts. Some people on the comments seemed to understand how this works, others wanted more info, so hopefully this Pro-Tip will be of help to some of our readers.

What do Bookies like and dislike?

- They don't like you making a profit!
- They like you to deposit cash into your account regularly
- They don't like you taking cash (profit) out of your account
- They like "mug punters" who keep feeding their losing habit by putting more cash into *their* coffers.

So, as long as you are a "mug punter" there would be no reason for them to close down your account or limit it. If you <u>always</u> make a net loss, <u>always</u> put cash in and <u>never</u> take any money off them, they will see you as just another mug.

So let's suppose you have a successful system, such as All By The Book, that you are running with a Bookie. The name of the game is to disguise the successful bets with "unsuccessful" ones. If you do this, they will see you as just another mug punter who makes profit every now and then and proceeds to blow it on impulse bets. You will look like their favourite sort of client

Here's how you set up "unsuccessful" bets:

- Pick a market, preferably one with plenty of selections, like a competitive horse race.
- Open the Bookies window on that market and open the market on Betfair simultaneously. You will need sufficient funding in your Betfair account to cover Lay bets.
- Basically you are going to transfer money from the Bookie account to the Betfair account, by picking losers to back with the bookie.
- Watch the odds offered by the Bookie and odds available on Betfair until you find a selection that has matched Lay odds on Betfair and Back odds on the Bookies. This happens more often than you might think and almost every UK horse race does have matching bets at some point or another on one or more selection before the off.
- Remember you want a horse that preferably loses, so it is best not to pick the favourite or second favourite.
- <u>Always</u> back first on the Bookies and watch out for the Bookie odds to have shortened. If they have shortened, refuse the bet, unless the Betfair odds have shortened to match.

- Once the Bookie has accepted your bet on the desired odds, quickly get a Lay <u>for the same amount</u> on Betfair at the same odds. Surprisingly, often the odds on Betfair are shorter, because you are basically spotting a horse that is shortening, which is why the Betfair odds matched the Bookie odds in the first place. Sometimes the odds on Betfair start drifting. This is not a disaster, because either the odds will shorten again, if you are patient or, if the horse is a drifter, then the Bookie odds will probably drift too.
- I am assuming you are using a Bookie who offers best odds guaranteed, so that if the SP is longer than the odds taken when you placed the bet, the Bookie will give you the better SP odds. ArbCruncher.com offer a free calculator that you can use to work out your Lay stake when the price drifts like this. Just put in the *estimated* SP odds, close to the off and the current Betfair Lay price and it will tell you what to stake on the Lay bet.
- If the Lay odds are shorter than the Back odds, you can stake a slightly lower amount on the Lay so the liability matches the potential winnings with the Bookie. This will offset the 5% commission if the Lay bet is successful.
- If there are no matching odds, leave the race alone, don't be tempted to back a horse with the Bookie in the hope that the Betfair price will shorten. This is not gambling, this is mathematics or accounting, so leave such a race alone. There will be plenty more races where you can appear to be a "mug" to the Bookie, you don't actually need to be one! (Grin!)

There are variations on this, taking into account the Betfair commission, but basically, when you get a losing bet with the Bookie, you are transferring your stake of £x from the Bookie to your Betfair account.

This is how you take your previous winnings out of your Bookie account without actually making a withdrawal and alerting the Bookie to your profitability. You are withdrawing your money by being a "mug" and backing a losing horse!

Of course the horse might win, in which case funds are transferred in the other direction from your Betfair account to the Bookie account. But let's face it; most horses lose, especially if you pick the 3rd favourite or longer, so in the long run your funds will move, on average, from the Bookie to Betfair.

Even if you have to pay 5% commission on the Betfair winning Lays, this is OK, because you are moving previous tax-free *profit*. So a 5% exchange rate on profits is acceptable. But as I said, often you can get better Lay odds on Betfair which off-sets the Betfair commission.

Never leave the Back bet with the Bookie hanging without a Lay bet. If you do this you are likely to lose some of your previous hard-earned profits from your successful system, if the horse is a loser. If the odds on the Exchange have drifted and you are not sure that the SP odds with the Bookie are going to match it, then lay the horse *at whatever the odds*. If it loses then your money will transfer successfully from Bookie to Betfair. If the horse wins then you will lose a little more on the Exchange than you win with the Bookie. But it is better to take a small hit like this, rather than risk leaving a Back bet unmatched.

I've been trialling this for a while and have been amazed at how easy this is to do. Here is a spreadsheet of actual bets that I placed on the 4th January. My aim was to transfer £100 previous profit from my Bookie account to my Betfair account. I've even managed to make a small net profit by introducing a small element of risk! With available Lay odds below the Back odds, I layed a slightly higher stake on the Lay bet and each losing horse made me a little profit as well as transferring the money from Bookie to Betfair.

So I had five "mug bets" with the Bookie, which disguised my previous success that had earned £100. The £100 was transferred by the losing horses to my Betfair account.

If one of the horses had won, it would simply have transferred funds from the Exchange to the Bookie and I would have worked over the next few days at selecting more losers to transfer the money back!

Let's face it, it is easier to select losers than to select winners, so sticking to relatively unfancied horses and matching the Back and Lay bets <u>will always</u> result in a net transfer of funds out of the Bookie account.

Once you have transferred the money out of the Bookie account, then you can fund your Bookie account with another deposit of cash and work your successful system along with these mug bets to transfer the winnings. The Bookie will love you! Of course you can withdraw your net winnings out of Betfair without any penalty from them.

Well, actually, at the present time, Betfair will penalise you if you are successful over a sustained period of time (a year or more), but that's another story and requires some nifty bet matching with BetDAQ. I hope to look at that in a future newsletter.

League Table

The systems under review have different starting banks, different stakes and some systems have variable stakes. A reasonable way of comparing the performance of systems is to work out the profit (or loss) as a percentage of the starting bank and to average this out over the number of the days of the review.

Sports Bet Gold, Champion Draws and Flat Ratings Pro are the three Current Reviews that are the ones to watch, although Flat Ratings Pro is only based upon ten days of testing.

Obviously this table doesn't replace reading the reviews, because <u>profit %age of bank per day</u> is not the only factor in judging a system. Nevertheless, I think it gives a valid comparison and an at-a-glance way of bringing the mass of data together.
