Backing Star Selection Service Introduction



Review Manager David-Introduces the Backing Star Selection Service

Hi Bloggers

I will be testing a new horse racing backing service from the Steve Davidson stable called *Backing Star Selection Service*, this is run by a gentleman called Mohit, it has a twist it has no less than 5 staking plans for you to choose from, 2 of these are at Level Stakes, 2 more are a percentage of your bank and finally the last one is a 1,2 and 4 points Staking Plan I have included a bit more detail taken from the website below.

STAKING PLANS:

PLAN A - ONLY FOR PLACE MARKET - LEVEL STAKES

- Divide your bank in 100 points and bet only two points per bet. This is simple level staking.

PLAN B - ONLY FOR PLACE MARKET

- Always stake 2% of your bank on each bet. Adjust your new stake accordingly after each bet.

PLAN C - ONLY FOR WIN MARKET - LEVEL STAKES.

- Divide your bank in 100 points and bet only two points per bet. This is simple level staking.

PLAN D - ONLY FOR EACH WAY BETS -

- Always stake 1.5% of your bank on win market & 1.5 % of your bank on place market for each bet. Adjust your new stake accordingly after each bet.

PLAN E (1-2-4)

Stake 1% of your bank in place market as long as place odd is 2.0 or above and below 4.0. If selection wins then stake 2% on the next selection and if this selection also wins then stake 4% on the next selection. And now come back to 1% independent of whether the next selection now wins or not. Remember that at any stage if selection get unplaced and you lose your bet then stake 1% on the next selection.

Now you are advised to bet 1 minute before the off this is to check for the number of runners if it exceeds a certain amount No Bet and also the place odds should not exceed 4.00 otherwise that is a no bet on either the Win or Place plans. If you cannot follow live betting then they suggest to bet using <u>Betfair SP</u> option. The website claims

a 27% Strike Rate for Win Bets and 58% for Place Bets and here is the table provided on the website of the profits made since July 2010:

For Plan A,B,C,D - Is the bank after starting with £1,000

For Plan 1-2-4 - Points profit per month on this single plan.

So the <u>Backing Star Selection Service</u> looks profitable so far, I will actually start the review of the Backing Star Selection Service from Monday 14th. I have been receiving selections since then and the e-mails have arrived on time so far, there is also so a members site where you can get your selections in case of e-mail problems and also catch up with results. The main reason for the delay in posting is that I have been working on an excelsheet to cover all 5 plans and automate the process as much as possible, also to make it easier to work ROI's etc in the Final Review. Now how much does the service cost? Well at present the subscription fees are as follows £29.97 for 1 months selections, £75.97 for 3 months, £119.97 for 6 months and finally £199.97 for a full 1 year which works out at a fraction over £16.66 as month if you break it down. I will base all my results to BSP, the E/W Bets will be split into win and place, each plan will have 100 points Start Bank and finally I will check the Racing Post to look for non runners etc which may have an effect on our selections being a bet or not. In order to reduce the size of each posting I will only include the qualifying bets but I will list the P/L and Running Banks for all Plans.

Betting Grenade - Final Review



Review Manager David-Reviews Betting Grenade

Hi Bloggers

Well this one was a real tricky one to try and judge but at the end of the day it finished with a 99.52 points profit and does what it says on the tin finds big priced winners so the fact that it had a 100.00 BFSP and a 49.78 priced winners cannot be considered a fluke because that is what the system is supposed to do.

So I have passed it and given it 3 stars.

Now given all this the system is one hell of a roller coaster ride, by mid December it almost broke its 100 point bank on reflection a 200 point bank would have been more appropriate and was an error on my part. The downside are the losing runs, given the odds of some selections this is really to be expected. During early to mid December it suffered a losing run of 51 and another of 24, these were the longest. Then of course it got the 100.00 priced winner in the latter half of the month.


I think the lack of racing and smaller fields did not help. As per the author, the actual strike rate increased but the odds were a lot less than normal so that was why it was struggling, things did pick up a lot better in January and February when some kind of normality was resumed in racing.

So what is *Betting Grenade?* Well it is a system that requires you to monitor live racing. During the review we concentrated on races with12 runners or less, so if you cannot follow live racing this is not for you. The rules are quite simple, the most selections we ever had in one day was 29 we had a few in the low 20's, and as low as 3 on one day. If you like a lot of bets then this one could be for you during the review period it had 1086 selections which resulted in 182 winners, now with that here are some stats:

1086 selections/182 winners = 16.76% Strike Rate Profit made during Review = 99.52 points Return on Investment = 9.16%

Average Price of Selection = 17.545 Average Price of Winner = 6.804

Now I would like to have shown the ups and downs of the daily totals but unfortunately due to space restriction I will have to make do with a graph showing the weekly profit and losses:



The graph clearly shows the roller coaster ride of this system, also I have included the stats for 5 and half months below:

As we can see only 1 month showed a loss and that was November whereas mentioned previously the strike rate had increased by around 2% but the average odds of winners had decreased by over a 1.5 points on the previous 2 months, interesting to note February is showing a low average but with a well above normal Strike Rate. Taking the total profit and the number of selections for the 5.5 months the Return on Investment would be 9.11% which is not great but still better than a lot of the stuff out there. Actually Betting Grenade is bucking the current trend by having level stake bets on higher odds whereas a lot of other products are having varied but a lot bigger stakes on low odds. For my own personal taste Betting Grenade has too many selections but then we are all different, anyway I looked at the results to see if there were any trends and a way to reduce the selections down here is what I came up with:

579 selections/74 winners = 12.78% Strike Rate Profit made during Review = 184.10 points Return on Investment = 31.80%

Average Price of Selection = 23.07 Average Price of Winner = 10.79

First thing we see is that I have decreased the number of selections by over 500, took a hit on strike rate by 3.98% but increased the average odds of the winner by nearly 4 points, I did manage to get the longest losing run down to 39 now I do not have access to try it out on September or October but did manage to try it out on the first part of November so here is the figures for 3.5 months:

Not to say that this is the greatest thing since sliced bread but it is showing promise but I would like to check it out more.

But in the meantime, for anyone who purchases Betting Grenade via our links, you can have the simple rule plus the results I have, free of charge. Just contact Gordon the BST/LTO Admin Manager, with proof of purchase, and he will forward them to you.

In conclusion an interesting system but in order to operate it you would need plenty of patience and discipline to survive the losing runs, also be able to follow the racing live and have internet access. In return you can get winners at very good odds which can be quite a thrill it also manages to make a profit too. As I mentioned earlier I prefer lesser selections but I know others like plenty so they would be catered for here. How much does it cost? Well at the time of publishing this it was available for £69.99.

Laying Winter Profits Final Review



Sgt Tony-Reviews Laying Winter Profits

FAILED (BUT ONLY JUST)

Laying Winter Profits has been an interesting system to review, as it concentrates on a specific method for laying horses specifically for the three 'winter' months of December, January and February. The author of the system, Chris Castell, also has 3 other seasonal systems, thereby covering the whole year in the four 'seasons'. Laying Autumn Profits (which I have already reviewed) covers the three months of September, October and November, Laying Summer Profits covers the three months of June, July and August and Laying Spring Profits (which I am currently reviewing) covers the three months of March, April and May. The author claims that the success of his seasonal systems lies in the fact that he is accounting for changing conditions throughout the year by only looking at the short term monthly or quarterly conditions. He has also asked me to bear in mind that he would like the four packages to be considered as one year around system, thus if a loss were to be incurred in one season it may well be offset by the profits of the other three systems. That said, I will obviously be reviewing it in isolation!

The author of <u>Laying Winter Profits</u> says that the staking plan he offers his clients is able to increase the profitability of his systems considerably, although we shall be using the level staking system of £100 per point for our review period, this is what is recorded on the Laying Winter Profits website and the <u>Betfair</u> commission of 5% is deducted. On that basis, a winning £100 stake produces a profit of £95. The author of Laying Winter Profits also now uses the published <u>Betfair</u> SP prices to record the results, rather than the odds that he is able to get using his betting bot.

This review of Laying Winter Profits started on 1 December, and the first month only selected horses from National Hunt races (all types, except Novice Handicap Chases). Due to the appalling weather, there were no selections at all for the first nine days and we then lost a further 6 days between 19th and 26th December, meaning that we lost 15 racing days out of 31! In addition, there were 9 other days in December when the system had no qualifying selections – which means that there were only 8 days in December when the system actually had qualifying selections at all! It was no surprise to find out that the system made a loss of -3.10 points at level stakes for December.

January saw the selections move to include those on the All Weather (Kempton, Lingfield and Southwell, but NOT Wolverhampton) and National Hunt races (except Handicap Hurdles, Novice Hurdles, Novice Handicap Chases and Novice Chases),

which gave a bigger range to choose from (although there were a couple of days in December when even the 'all weather' racing was called off due to bad weather!). I was abroad for the whole of January, so I am not sure if any days were lost to the weather completely, but there were 9 days in January when there were no qualifying selections. Leaving all of that aside for a moment, Laying Winter Profits made a loss of -4.04 points at level stakes for January.

February saw the system move back to concentrate only on National Hunt races, with the exception of Handicap Hurdles, Novice Handicap Hurdles and National Hunt Flat (NHF) races. I was abroad for most of February, but don't think that we experienced any severe weather problems, although there were ten days when there were no qualifying selections. It made a profit of 5.00 points at level stakes for February.

Here are the statistics for the 3 months:

Selections 96/72 Winning Lays = 75% Strike Rate
Profit and Loss = minus 2.14 points
Average Price of Selection = 4.71 BSP
Average Price of Losing Lays = 3.94 BSP
Longest Winning Run = 11 (once)
Longest Losing Run = 3 (once)

As can be seen from the figures the longest losing run was 3 selections, which happened only once, there were winning runs (i.e. the selection lost the race!) of 11, 8, 7, 6 and similar over the three months. In summary, the system is very easy to use, has relatively low risk as can be seen from the average odds of 3.94 for losing lays, but it did end up with a small loss of 2.14 points. That said, a loss over the three month review period cannot be ignored, it could almost be considered a neutral case but of course we no longer have that and anyway as I shall be doing an overall review of all 4 seasonal packages as one, all is not lost as a minus 2.14 points could be easily made up by the remaining Spring and Summer Laying Profit reviews.

Throughout the whole review period, Chris Castell has been extremely helpful in answering all my questions, has responded to all of my emails promptly and efficiently and has always delivered the selections accurately and on time. He has also published all the results quickly and accurately. The results over recent years have been consistently profitable and you do not have to sit at the PC all day watching the racing, as you get the selections the night before racing (or just make your own selections from the manual) and can simply place your bets using the recommended Betfair SP odds limits.

Laying Winter Profits costs £97 to purchase, which would increase the loss by another point. If you had opted to receive the monthly selections by email at a cost of £97 per month, this would have increased the loss even further. Laying Winter Profits is very well written and easy to follow, so I would not personally have opted to receive the selections, but that choice is obviously up to the individual.

Current Reviews

Period of Reviews

Some debate has been going on as regards the length of time that services should be reviewed on. A decision has been made, by our admin, Gordon!

- 1. If the product is "busy" i.e. there are normally selections every day, we go for the initial 56 day review, as currently, and then make a decision as to whether to continue or not. For these products we adopt a 56 "betting days" policy, so any day with no selections, for whatever reason, is not counted.
- 2. If the product is not busy, a "slow burner" as I call them, we will adopt a different policy. If it is obvious that there are only going to be one or two betting days per week, then we go straight to a full 84 day review. In this case it is just 12 weeks. However I think we will leave the option open for the reviewer to choose to go for 84 "betting Days" should they choose.

The idea is that the longer the review, and the more bets we can include, the better that is for everyone, readers, vendors, authors alike.

League Table of Current Reviews

The systems under review have different starting banks, different stakes and some systems have variable stakes. A reasonable way of comparing the performance of systems is to work out the profit (or loss) as a percentage of the starting bank and to average this out over the number of the days of the review.

Obviously this table doesn't replace reading the reviews, because <u>profit %age of bank per day</u> is not the only factor in judging a system. Nevertheless, I think it gives a valid comparison and an at-a-glance way of bringing the mass of data together.



Profitability Graph

Here is a graph of the profit being made by the front-runners as a percentage of their starting bank. This gives a week by week comparative view of their progress.

It gives a representation of the volatility or dependability of each system. I've taken off the reviews that have finished. Ideally we would want a graph that increased each week by roughly the same amount. If a system or tipping service could produce that, then we would really have a winning review! Betfair Success Formula has recovered well from its big loss of a few weeks ago, but as explained in the review, one result going the wrong way would cause another big fall.
