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Assured Soccer Profits – Introduction

12th July 2011



Inspector Karl-Introduces Assured Soccer Profits

Hi Bloggers

Assured Soccer Profits (ASP) is from the John Duncan stable and is the latest product on to the market promising slow and steady results, rather than instant riches, it is a long 90 page e-book, and costs at present £78.32. So it is not the cheapest. You only need a small bank to start, the e-books recommends £200 and exclusively uses [Betfair](#)

What is it then?

Assured Soccer Profits uses Betfair to lay certain scenarios in the first half of the football match to allow you to close out at half time with a profit, also it teaches you what to do if things go wrong, and as the author states "They will go wrong" and the idea is he teaches you how not to panic. If you like to blame someone this system won't be for you as you could have a 100 people on using this system on the same match and most of them would act differently to each other.

We are promised steady profits, mostly around the £4 per match, this is trading and you do need to be at your computer, the system claims you can make £20 per day on only 3 matches, and that is certainly possible if all the matches conform to the "perfect" set up.

Assured Soccer Profits uses a 4 point check to allow you the best possible chance of achieving the ideal match. The system also claims you can use any match at any time of the day. And rule 4 is a liquidity rule and I will point out that I have been checking the morning matches since I had the

ebook and all of them so far have had nowhere near the liquidity to qualify, I would argue it may be best to run this through the main football seasons, but the ebook goes to great lengths to stress this is not the case so I will start running it straight away.

The first 35 pages of the e-book are fantastic, and second half is a pain, and I had a headache by the time I had finished reading the second half as it goes into a lot of detail about what to do when things go wrong so a fair bit of mathematics is involved.

There is video tutorial page which makes things so much easier to understand, and I feel they would have been better telling people to use the video tutorial rather than trying to read the second half of the book.

The author of Assured Soccer Profits goes to great pains to stress that if things go wrong then you as the user are doing something wrong. Also the e-book tries to teach you to accept taking a small loss rather than risk a large loss

There are some issues I have spotted and having a couple of practice runs can see all is not as black and white as perhaps the book makes out, and if the match starts to go against you be prepared to do some fast thinking to work out stakes for recovery, there is a handy calculator provided to help you. (Though I never got this so I will have to use my noggin) The book says most matches are done by Half Time and if the perfect set up continues then yes they will be. When things do go wrong quite often you need the second half to not suffer a loss. If you try this system please do not jump in, I have had the e-book 4 days now and I am still re-watching the videos, and be very careful if you decide to do multi matches at once as you do need to concentrate.

There is a "perfect storm" where you could suffer a big loss, but the author does state this is very rare, and does spend several pages showing us the stats to back up that claim.

Let's recap.

This is Trading

This is a formula not tips

You use a 4 point check to make sure the match fits.

Everyone's profits will differ.

Understand you are at the mercy of Betfair actually putting the match in-play, I think we have all been there when the "Suspended" sign never disappears, even though it says it is going in-play.

I will do this review more on theory of the Assured Soccer Profits system rather than the cold hard profit, as someone who has 12 hours free a day could make much more than me who only has a few hours a day free.

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Backing Star Selection Service – Final Review Plan C

Hi Bloggers

Seems a while back since we started the review but to just refresh the memory *Backing Star Selection Service* is an e-mail selection service where by you receive a certain number of horses and then just before the off you check that the selections race to make sure it has no more than 9 runners and that the bet itself is no higher than 4.00 on the [Betfair](#) place market these Rules apply to Plans A,B,C and D if the two rules mentioned previous are passed then you have a bet, there is one further Plan and that is E now apart from the 9 runner rule the odds to be a qualifier must be between 2.00 to 4.00 inclusive on the [Betfair](#) place market. Now Plans A

and C are to level stakes and then the others are percentage of the bank and in the case of Plan E it is a 1, 2 and 4 point staking plan. I have produced the staking part below from my initial introduction:

STAKING PLANS:

PLAN A – ONLY FOR PLACE MARKET – LEVEL STAKES

- Divide your bank in 100 points and bet only two point per bet. This is simple level staking.

PLAN B – ONLY FOR PLACE MARKET

- Always stake 2% of your bank on each bet. Adjust your new stake accordingly after each bet.

PLAN C – ONLY FOR WIN MARKET – LEVEL STAKES.

- Divide your bank in 100 points and bet only two point per bet. This is simple level staking.

PLAN D – ONLY FOR EACH WAY BETS -

- Always stake 1.5% of your bank on win market & 1.5 % of your bank on place market for each bet.

Adjust your new stake accordingly after each bet.

PLAN E (1-2-4)

Stake 1% of your bank in place market as long as place odd is 2.0 or above and below 4.0. If selection wins then stake 2% on the next selection and if this selection also wins then stake 4% on the next selection.

And now come back to 1% independent of whether the next selection now wins or not. Remember that at any stage if selection get unplaced and you lose your bet then stake 1% on the next selection.

Now having got that that out of the way the only Plan that produced a profit at the 56 day stage of this review was Plan C which is Level Stakes on the win market now I will be dividing this service into 4 separate final reviews A& B I will do together as they use the same approach, Plan C this one and then followed by Plans D and E separately.

Well that's enough background what happened during the review well here are some stats to digest for the whole of the review then we will have a look at the weekly profit and loss graph:

Backing Star Selection Service Plan C

Breakdown

Selections 508/ Winners 148 = 29.15% S/R

Average Price of Selection = 4.87

Average price of winner = 3.77 (rounded off)

Longest Losing run = 12 (3 times), 11 (3 times)

Longest Winning Run = 9 (once), 4 (once)

Profit after [Betfair](#) Commission 59.95 points to 2pt L/S


Return on Investment = 5.90%

Now let's have a look at how Backing Star Selection Service performed weekly over the review period:



Well the first 4 weeks went reasonably well and the service hit a respectable 163.83 on the fourth week its highest peak during the whole review it was actually during the end of this week April 11th to be precise that things went into decline and continued a downward trend until May 5th where the service rallied slightly. For the rest of May it remained stagnant it actually went as low as 71.29 points on May 31st so had lost 28.71% of the starting bank, come the 1st of June things all suddenly changed and by the 2nd week in June Week 12 the service was buzzing. So what happened after the review had finished did the service continue to perform yes it did from June 11th to June 31st it made another 78.34 points so for the whole of the month of June it made 167 points profit which the service has never achieved in any other month as we shall see, to counterbalance this July has started of very badly from the 1st to the 10th it has lost 48.44 points. To get a better overall picture let's look at the results in a graph from the time the service was started which was July 23rd 2010 up to July 10th 2011 so very nearly one year:

Backing Plan C Full Results



So the graph shows us that Backing Star Selection Service has made a steady rise in profits and of course a steeper rise when we hit June and with a sudden drop due to July's poor results so just to complete the round up here is the stats breakdown for the full period:

Profit after [Betfair](#) Commission = 276.75 points to 2 points

Level Stakes

Return on Investment = 9.53%

Conclusion

This one has certainly been a testing Final Review to do and certainly time consuming I will try and do the other Plans as soon as I can. Now one reason that Plan C was able to recover quicker than the other Plans was that it is straight forward win betting, some of the place odds on the other Plans were very low although they will recover but albeit very slowly, anyway we will cover this in the other Final Reviews. One of the reasons the Final Review took longer was due to what happened during the review ie the big slump after 4 weeks and then a stagnation period these took up over half the review and the last week finishing strongly I decided to monitor it for a few more weeks and check what happened before I started the review. The conclusion I came to was that it was a freak period the service has had a few losing months before but not consecutive, the winning run did continue throughout the rest of June but the returns were way above the profits made in any previous months so this again could also be classed as a freak period. If we take the actual review period despite the ups and downs Plan C would have still passed a ROI of 5.90% was good enough for this, but I think a clearer picture of what the service is capable of, can be seen in the full results data and graph a

steady rise in profits most of the time with just an occasional dip and a profit of 276.75 points which equates to 23.72 points a month this using 2 points level stakes and heading close to a 10% ROI.

The e-mails for the most part turned up well before racing and quite often before 9am, and only once did I did not receive an e-mail but you always have the backup of the members page which gives you the selections too. What is the cost of the service? at the moment you have 4 options, monthly at £29.97, 3 months at £75.97, 6 months at £119.97 and best value 12 months at £199.97 which is equivalent to 16.66 per month so overall the subscription fees are quite reasonable.

So downsides well in order to know if you have a qualifying selection you are advised to check the [Betfair](#) Place market just before the off to make sure its place odds are not greater than 4.00 and also that the race has no more than 9 runners this means that you would need computer access when racing is on although you would not need to spend all afternoon or evening because you already have the times of the possible selections. As far as I know there is no bot on the market that can check the [Betfair](#) place odds and then place a bet on the [Betfair](#) win market if a horse qualifies because the two markets are independent. From my own point of view I would like to have seen a few more substantial winning runs besides the winning sequences already mentioned there was quite a few hatrick of wins but I just feel there is a slight inbalance between the losing and winning runs. You really cannot afford to miss a day when you have received your e-mail selections it has produced some good priced winners and sometimes they come out of the blue this happened a couple of times during the review. Certainly you will need to be disciplined and stay focused to survive the losing runs and not to miss a bet as I mentioned in the previous sentence it does have some good priced winners.

So taking all the factors into consideration and the reasonable price of Backing Star Selection Service I have decided to award it 3 stars.

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League Table of Current Reviews

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The systems under review have different starting banks, different stakes and some systems have variable stakes. A reasonable way of comparing the performance of systems is to work out the profit (or loss) as a percentage of the starting bank. Obviously this table doesn't replace reading the reviews, because *profit as %age of bank* is not the only factor in judging a system. Nevertheless, I think it is a valid at-a-glance way of bringing the mass of data together.

I've colour coded the reviews that are the currently most successful, with the colour of their profitability graph to make them easier to spot. Some of the older or suspended reviews have been taken off and it looks like The Low Lay might be taken off next week.

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
Profitability Graph

It gives a representation of the volatility or dependability of each system. Ideally we would want a graph that increased each week by roughly the same amount. If a system or tipping service could produce that, then we would really have a winning review!

I've had another question from a reader, concerning [Betting Profits Soccer System](#), which is suspended until the start of the football season:

Hi Rich,

I tried a soccer correct scores service last season (reviewed and failed on BST) with great success at first - then it went into and stayed loss making. I found it rather time consuming to get the 48 bets on at best odds available.

I am curious about your Soccer System , if it is still available.

I need to know :-

how simple is it (I know almost nothing about soccer),
how specific is it (I don't want to have to use too much discretion)
and how much time is involved in operating your Soccer System.

If it is not too demanding for me to operate I would be prepared to buy the useless Betting Profits software through BST in order to get your Soccer System details.

Here is my reply:

It's a little difficult as essentially this has become a review of my own system based upon general advice given with Betting Profits. I'm hardly independent anymore!

It is simple and not too time consuming, but you do need to understand Betfair markets and prices. You need to consult league tables – I use Betdevil.com. You need to look at the last three results for a team in a cup match – I use futbol24.com for that. Then you need to understand the Betfair Correct Score market.

It takes maybe five minutes to go through a league's or cup's fixtures. I stick to the major leagues, not minor ones. I tend to pick one major match at any kick-off time, just to keep life simple. Working out the stakes using a dutching calculator and getting the bets on may take another few minutes. Then you just let the matches run through to Final Whistle.

The review will continue when genuine competitive soccer restarts and some form is established – probably around early September.
