***Is it too early to announce three successful reviews?*** Although still mid-review, we have three reviews that show profit **every week** that they have been reviewed! Bonus Bagging, RebelBetting and Tommy's ABSX Method. They are all making steady progress, *week on week*. What would happen to our betting pot if we followed those three and only those three?

Bonus Bagging's pot would have more than doubled. Tommy's ABSX pot would have increased by 37% and the RebelBetting pot would have increased by over 34%! You can check all this info for yourself, in the Current Reviews, League Table and Profitability Graph sections of this newsletter.

### **What is Football Filter Premium?**

**Football Filter Premium** is a piece of [software](#), designed to provide selections from various football leagues from around the world.

There is also a tipping service available, if you cannot or do not want to run *Football Filter Premium* [software](#).

The cost with either method is free for the first fifteen days, then \$69.99 (approximately £42.90 at current rates) per month.

The Football Filter Premium [software](#) produces a number of selections, and the advice provided with the software is to combine the top three selections in a trixie bet. (For those unfamiliar with this term, as I was, this is a combination of three double bets and a treble).

As the software produces one bet per week, this review will last for 12 weeks.

At the same time you download the software, there is a four page PDF document, with a link to a video showing how the software is to be used.

As there is no advice to staking or a bank to be available, I will use a bank of 50 points, and one point per bet, meaning that the Trixie bet will use four points.

The first results will be shown here very shortly, and I look forward to seeing how this system performs during to the review.

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## Betfair: Truths, Lies and Statistics – Part 2

Summary of last week's rather gloomy, but honest, article

1. The consensus is that Betfair's prices are the most accurate assessment of the probability of an outcome
2. On average we won't make a profit either backing or laying, whatever the price on Betfair
3. - unless the odds being offered represent "value" in that they are longer than the actual probability of the result
4. The outcome of each race or event is statistically independent of any previous races or events.
5. Staking systems that are dependent on winning or losing "runs" stopping, are statistically flawed.
6. You can take the probability of success/failure, from this predict the likelihood of various lengths of losing and winning runs and from this work out a loss recovery or profit maximization strategy and alter your stakes accordingly

This week I am going to concentrate on #1 above. But first a word about #6 - likely losing or winning runs.

There is a great piece of software called "[The Staking Machine](#)" which I will be reviewing in detail in the future. But this week I just want to mention one neat feature of this software. You can take any series of results and the software will predict for you the likely maximum losing runs.

This is an example of a sample of 27 races with 7 winning bets. Towards the bottom of the right hand box you can see that the longest losing sequence in the 27 races is 6. But highlighted a little further up, you can see that the software predicts that the Expected Losing Sequence for that sample size is 11. Therefore you would be fooling yourself if you based your stakes upon expecting a losing run of only 6!

Worse still, if you load up the Expected Losing Run Calculator, included with the software:

Expected Losing Sequence Calculator

Expected Losing Sequence. This is based on your strike rate and number of total bets. As total bets increases so will your expected losing sequence. When deciding on a staking plan you need to make sure the staking plan can absorb the expected losing sequence. And remember, you could get the expected losing sequence followed by a winner, followed by another expected losing sequence. The formula used is shown below in the Microsoft Excel format. You can copy paste this into Microsoft Excel and play around with it yourself.

`=ROUND(LN(sample size)/LN((1-(strike rate/100))),1)`

Here, you can see that, based upon that sample of results, in 100 races you can expect a losing run of 15 and in 10,000 races you can expect 30 consecutive losers.

So a staking plan that "hopes" these maximum runs don't happen will eventually fail, because such a run **will** happen at some stage. Conversely a staking plan that "expects" these maximum runs to happen and can allow for them, will succeed. A note of caution, once a maximum run has occurred; the chances of it happening again, immediately, are just as likely as they were before it happened. (See last week's article with reference to someone winning the lottery jackpot twice). So your staking plan must make a profit over time, no matter when the losing runs occur.

So if you play the prices offered on Betfair and if they are an accurate measure of probability, you have to have a staking system that allows for the expected losing runs. I will analyse the use of the above software in a future newsletter to see if the software can help us achieve that.

### Are Betfair Prices Accurate?

If they are then we could do worse than to simply use Betfair prices as an accurate assessment of a horse's chances and look for value odds elsewhere. Similarly if the Betfair prices are accurate and we see the Betfair odds shortening towards the off-time, it would be fair to assume that the horse's chances of winning are increasing! So there are two betting strategies for you!

Any serious bettor will want nothing more than to know the accurate probability of an event taking place.

Dave Nevison, a well-known gambler, in his book, "A Bloody Good Winner" says the following about Betfair:

"Recently I've hardly been playing on Betfair at all. The markets are now dictated by the betting exchanges, which means they are set by some of the cleverest people in the game, so they are likely to be more accurate predictors of the results than the traditional market."

"Betfair was a brilliant idea, brilliantly executed, but betting on betting exchanges increasingly reminds me of trading on currency markets. You are betting against some of the best betting brains in the world. You can't see the people you are betting against, some of whom have information you don't have. As a result, the market on Betfair now provides a more accurate picture of the true winning chance of each horse than ever before. You have a near-perfect market in which I can still make a profit, but I have to turn over a lot of money to do so because the margins are small. I think it will end up as a market in which no one will win a lot of money, apart from Betfair itself, from its commission charges."

"Now, Betfair lets everyone know what price each horse should be and bookmakers don't set their own prices any more. The last career you would want to pursue now is that of a horserace odds-compiler. Who needs them, when there is Betfair?"

So that is an authoritative opinion on the accuracy of Betfair. Next week I will look at the statistical evidence that supports this point of view.

Meanwhile take heart! If Betfair is an accurate book of true probability, you can simply use the Betfair market to find a bookie that is offering longer odds than the actual chance (Betfair price) that the horse has. Or you can use Betfair to spot horses in the parade ring or going down to the Start, that look good and whose probability of winning is increasing (odds shortening).

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## League Table of Current Reviews

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A reasonable way of comparing the performance of systems is to work out the profit (or loss) as a percentage of the starting bank. Obviously this table doesn't replace reading the reviews, because *profit as %age of bank* is not the only factor in judging a system. Nevertheless, it is a valid at-a-glance way of bringing the mass of data together.

I've colour coded the reviews that are the currently most successful, with the colour of their profitability graph to make them easier to spot. Some of the suspended reviews have been taken off the graph.

As it has made a profit every week, it is hardly surprising that Bonus Bagging has risen to the top of the table. Two other top performers, Betfair Success Formula and Betting Profits Soccer will be re-starting once the major soccer form has been established.

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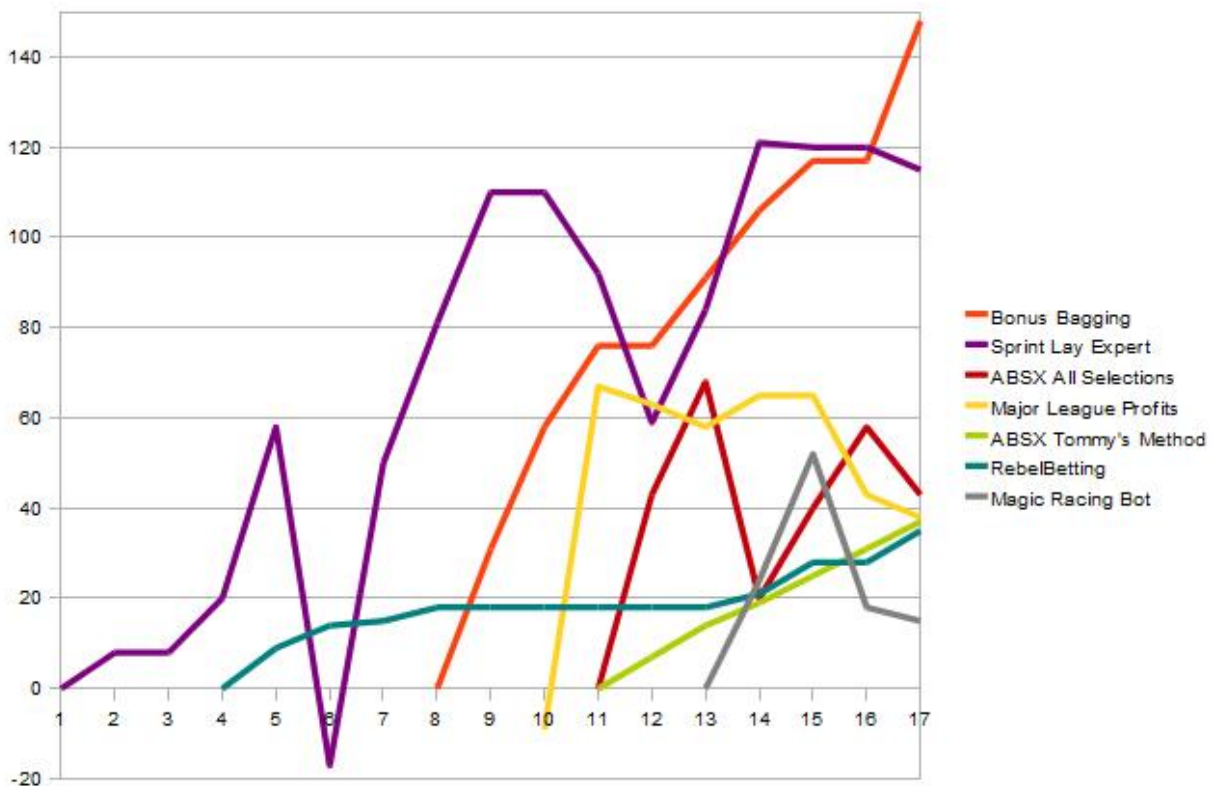
## Profitability Graph

Here is a graph of the profit being made by the front-runners as a percentage of their starting bank. This gives a week by week comparative view of their progress.

It gives a representation of the volatility or dependability of each system. Ideally we would want a graph that increased each week by roughly the same amount. If a system or tipping service could produce that, then we would really have a winning review!

We currently have **three outstanding** examples of this! Bonus Bagging, Tommy's ABSX method and RebelBetting (with the horizontal section when the review was suspended during the summer), where each of them go up by about the same amount every week!
