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Stateside Sports Pro Introduction

Sgt Jonny Introduces Stateside Sports Pro

Hi Bloggers, it's Sgt Jonny, a new reviewer here at Betting System Truths. I've actually used the Betting System Truths website for some time now, and recently made the decision to become a reviewer here! I'm a part-time trader on Betfair, and I also like to investigate other methods of profiting from sportsbooks. Hopefully I'll be able to bring some of my experience to this review.

Stateside Sports Pro, despite the name, is a service giving out "soccer" tips. This is a straightforward tipster service providing back-bets to its members.

Cory Daniels, the tipster behind Stateside Sports Pro, says he has been making a living from betting for the last three years and has now decided to share his picks with his members.

The Stateside Sports Pro service has actually been beta testing since the 1st of July. The results of this testing have been fully verified by Betting System Truths and the service has turned a £100 starting bank into £248 in the last three months. This gives an extremely respectable 148% ROI! These results are available as an excel spreadsheet to download from the website. (link to the website is at the bottom of this introduction)

These tips have been given out completely free, and will continue to be until the 31st of October, when it will become a paid service. The cost has yet to be confirmed, but is likely to include a sign-up fee as well as monthly installments.

Picks are sent out by email, normally in the morning, and there are normally around three picks a day. All picks are football, but are for a variety of countries and competitions as well as in a variety of markets. There have been picks from the final result, Under/over and Asian

Handicap markets among others. Average odds are 1.79 with a strike rate of 66.5%.

The recommended staking plan is 2% of the bank, with the 2% recalculated each day. I'll try to record results for a standard fixed 1 point per bet staking plan as well as the recommended one. I'll start with a 100 point bank.

This review will be for 56 days, unless I see a reason to extend it. Hopefully I'll be posting updates every two or three days. Feel free to post any comments and I'll post a reply as soon as I can.

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ZH Subscribe – Introduction

Hello Bloggers,

ZH Subscribe comes from the Zero Hype website and is a subscription based lay tipping service for football.

The team at Zero Hype offer a fourteen day free trial of ZH Subscribe, then a payment choice of £15 per month, or £150 per year.

Their website clearly states that no refunds will be made, and recommends that new subscribers take a monthly deal initially, to make sure that they are happy with the service, before extending their subscription, should they so wish.

They currently concentrate on seven major leagues across the globe:

England's Premier League and Championship
Italy's Serie A
Spain's La Liga
Norway's Tippaligaen

Major League Soccer from the States
and Brazil's Campeonato

According to the results shown on the website, there have been ten selections for August and September, with an expectation of eight to sixteen selections a month, which looks ideal for those that do not wish to be overloaded with bets.

This review will cover a twelve week period, as there will not be bets every day.

Zero Hype Subscribe also offer the opportunity to receive selections via SMS to advise when a selection has been issued, and appears from the instruction video to take a couple of minutes to set up.

Each selection will advise a liability to be risked on each selection, together with advice as to when the bet should be traded, hopefully when the plan goes in the right direction.

The review will start with a £500 bank, the first results will be shown here shortly, and I look forward to seeing how ZH Subscribe's selections perform during the review.

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Lay Of The Day – Introduction

Hi **Inspector Colin**
here. This is my first review for Lay The Odds. I'm recently retired, but spent most of my working life evaluating other people's ideas to see whether they worked – so this seems like a natural progression. My main interests are in sports betting – but I also like to see whether anyone can really crack the horse racing game.

This review is of the **Lay of the Day** service provided by Zero Hype. As the name suggests it is a tipping service, selecting one horse per day to lay (lose). The advice is made by e-mail, and costs £15 per month. Zero Hype also provide a week's free trial, and highlight that Fairbot, their recommended bot to utilise, is available on a 15 day trial (although an annual subscription is \$99, currently £64). ZeroHype also offer this service as part of a broader horse rating ratings package – but I will be restricting this review to the *Lay Of The Day* package.

The initial review will be for 56 betting days, with an option to extend to 84 betting days if the trial proves successful.

The staking plan is advised by ZeroHype, with the majority of the stakes being @ 0.5% of the betting bank (stakes in this case being liabilities). Some bets are higher depending upon the perceived risk. This system is therefore not a get rich quick scheme, and is sold as a slow & steady way to make profits. I'm going to start with a 1000 point bank, and show performance utilising the staking plan and to level stakes.

I will be starting the review in early October, and will look to post the results daily.

First impressions? The website shows performance history of the product, always a good sign in my eyes, which is profitable, but not spectacularly so. The founders of ZeroHype are accessible via e-mail, and seem helpful. They provide more than one service (which may spread them a little thin) but they seem to have a decent track record. Let's see if it stands up to scrutiny!

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Football Formula – Final Review

It's Time To Cash In On The Planets No.1 Sport!



9th October 2011

Inspector John Reviews Football Formula

This review was suspended following Day 56 after it was felt that the service was not making any progress after foundering in the Doldrums for long periods.

The start was fine. On the first day, with only two bets on two matches, a profit of 15.9 points was made and there was profit for the next four of the five days (the one-day loss was 0.5 points), taking the total profit in six days to 52.1 points. Could this be it...could this be my first five-star review?



Sadly no. The 52.1 points profit was to be the highest it achieved and after 14 days it had collapsed to almost zero, powered by a massive 36-point loss on Day 14. It did pick up and was making 36.44 points by Day 21, in arrears four days later, then back up to 39.53 points profit by Day 30.

This was its last peak and three days later it went into recession for the rest of the review (at one time losing 121.19 points) before closing with a 65.03 points deficit.

The **Football Formula** service organisation was good. Emails arrived a day in advance, easy to read, included start times of every match and there was only one day when there were no selections. What I did find daunting was, in the first half of the review, the amount of points invested in any one day. The second day of the review no less than 36 points were risked, although it did make 4.84 points, but that is a big wedge to risk on any one day, in my opinion. By the middle of September the investments were reduced substantially and, if you recall the betting "strengths" explained in the Introduction: *10pts maximum bet Super Confident bet that we cannot*

see losing, 8pts Very Confident bet that we expect to win, 6pts Confident bet that should win and 4pts Good value bet that has a good to fair chance of winning, these slowly went out the window as we saw bets of 1.7 points and 2.2 points as the author attempted to build his bank steadily, but it just did not work. By the 18th September, when this came into play, the bank was already light by 73.93 points and it did not help when on the first day of these new "strengths" it lost 13.4 points.

To summarize: the starting bank was 300 points; using the suggested staking plan this closed on 234.97 points, a 65.03 points loss; using level one-point stakes this closed on 126.14 points, a loss of 173.86 points. The cost of the service is £90 for a 90-day subscription, but there is a 28-day membership for £45.

It is a shame that the average profit of 45 points per month proofed by Betfan did not materialise. It appeared to be achieving this early on, but fizzled out like a rocket in the rain. It is obvious the three authors of the *Football Formula* are dead keen and put their heart into it, but it is results that count and not enough good ones counted during this review.

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Magic Racing Bot – Final Review

Short extract from my intro.

Magic Racing Bot, from Betting Bots Worldwide, is not a general betting bot. It only uses Magic Racing service selections. Magic Racing Bot is an automated betting bot. **There will be six lay selections uploaded to the bot each day** and the amount of action will vary depending on whether they end up inside our min-max odds range, but most days you are expected to have 3 or 4 lays successfully placed. Minimum odds are 1.75 and maximum odds are 5.0 for all selections.

Review results – both points and EURO :

Starting bank ~ 75 points (150 EURO) – 1 point = 2 EURO (minimum bet allowed on betfair).

Final Bank after 84 days ~ 125.95 points (251.90 EURO).

ROI ~ 10%.

Winning lays 163 from 223 bets – strike rate ~ 73%.

Average Lay Odds ~ 3.77.

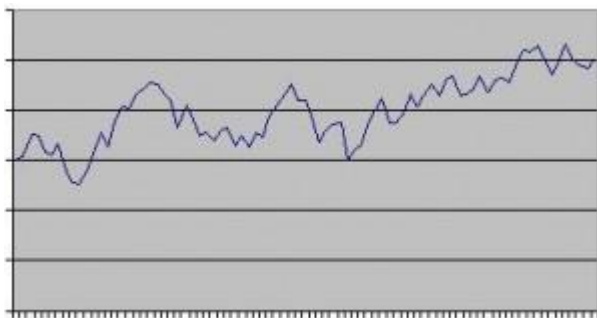
Return of Starting bank ~ 68%.

Longest wining run ~ 12 (2 times).

Longest losing run ~ 3 (5 times).

Overall profit ~ 50.95 points (101.90 EURO).

Here is the bank evolution:



On levels stake the result are:

Starting bank ~ 75 points (150 EURO) – 1 point – 2 EURO

Final Bank after 84 days ~ 85.62 points (171.24 EURO).

ROI ~ 4.70%.

Winning lays 163 from 223 bets – strike rate ~ 73%.

Average Lay Odds ~ 3.77.

Return of Starting bank ~ 14.16%.

Longest wining run ~ 12 (2 times).

Longest losing run ~ 3 (5 times).

Overall profit ~ 10.62 points (21.24 EURO).

This shows the effectiveness of the Magic Racing Bot staking method compared to level stakes.

All of this gives a **4 star rating** - easy to use, no risk (four times only under the starting bank), good ROI, excellent support .

Hi Bloggers,

I'll be short on this final review because the things are simple.

The intro in short :

Major League Profits football betting service operates with a recommended **starting bank of 20 points**. The service provides between 3 and 6 tips, with a brief synopsis, directly in your inbox, 24 hours before kickoff. Back bets only, no laying and no exchange requirement. The tips could be **straight win bets, over/under total goals bets, Asian handicap bets and occasional parlay. Coverage of Major League Profits** – complete MLS season, including MLS Cup Playoffs and final in November, occasional bets from US Open Cup and CONCACAF Champions League matches involving MLS teams.

Major League Profits service costs £25.00 per month and two discounted packages are also available for half a season the price is £49.00 and full season £98.00.

And now the review statistics after the review period with an extended period :

Starting Bank = 20 points

Running Bank after Week 15 = 18.98 points (loss 1.02 points)

Number of selections = 88 / Winning selections = 36 -> Strike Rate = 40.91%

ROI = -1.16%

Bank Evolution:



For £100 for 1 point as the results are displayed on the site after the review period the loss is £102 plus the fee of the service (3 months X £25).

Unfortunately, **Major League Profits** will have to be consigned to the failed category

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League Table of Current Reviews

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A reasonable way of comparing the performance of systems is to work out the profit (or loss) as a percentage of the starting bank. Obviously this table doesn't replace reading the reviews, because *profit as %age of bank* is not the only factor in judging a system. Nevertheless, it is a valid at-a-glance way of bringing the mass of data together.

I've colour coded the reviews that are the currently most successful, with the colour of their profitability graph to make them easier to spot.

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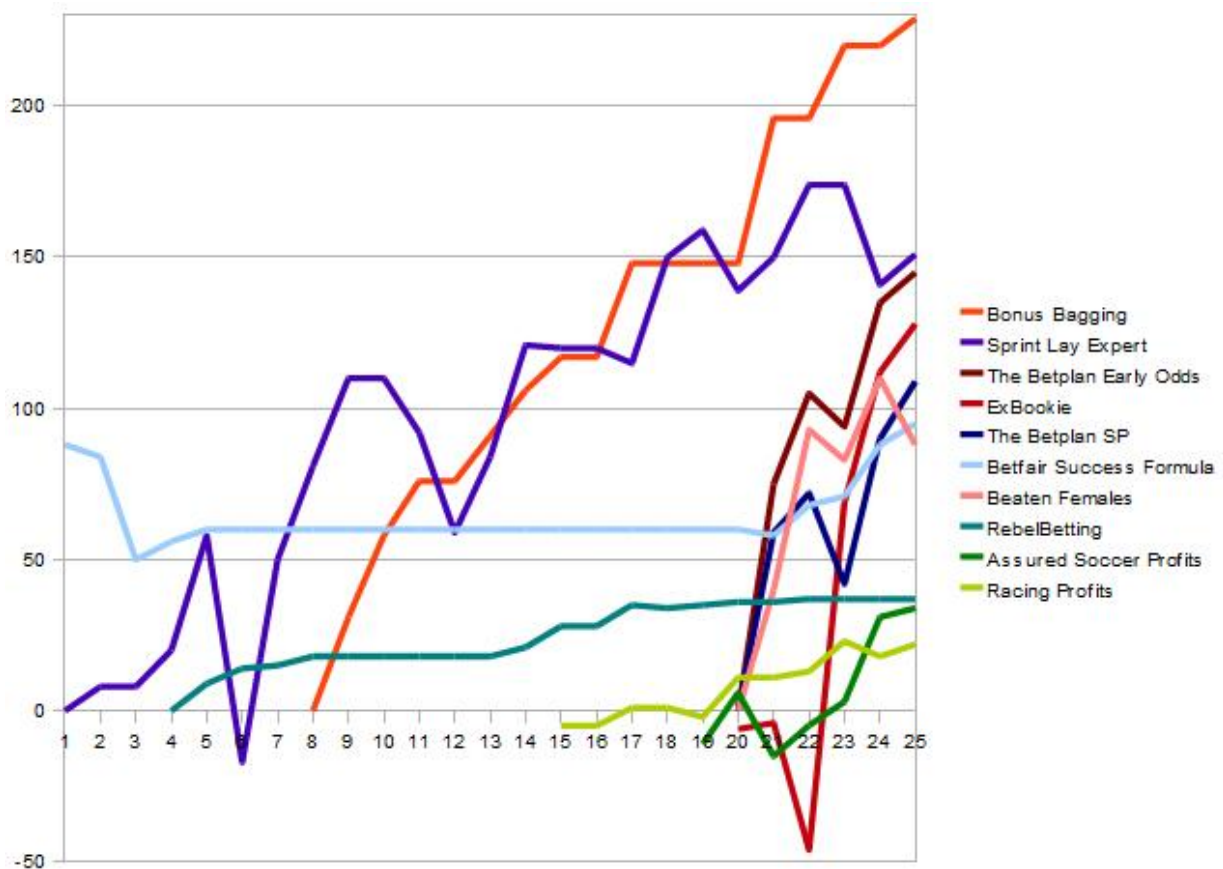
Profitability Graph

Here is a graph of the profit being made by the front-runners as a percentage of their starting bank. This gives a week by week comparative view of their progress.

It gives a representation of the volatility or dependability of each system. Ideally we would want a graph that increased each week by roughly the same amount. If a system or tipping service could produce that, then we would really have a winning review!

I'm only including those that are currently making over 20% profit. Bonus Bagging is far and away the best performing system during its review period.
