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Dream Lays – Introduction



Sgt Tony Introduces Dream Lays

Hi All

I am Tony and my preference is more for laying systems rather than backing systems (although I did back Italy to beat Germany at 4/1 on Thursday). I am a scuba diving instructor, so I travel quite a lot, but still find time to place bets and do systems reviews wherever I am in the world. All you need is a mobile phone and a laptop and your office is open for business!

As the name suggest, Dream Lays is a laying service provided by Keith and his team that covers UK Flat and National Hunt racing. The service only seeks to place lay bets when the odds of the recommended selections fall under 3.00 using the SP on Betfair.

Each day, there are ten or so selections, but these will not all turn into bets, as the SP odds will not always be under 3.00 on Betfair. They advise placing your bets in the ten minutes leading up to the off. This will not be practical for those of you who do not have access to bookies during the day, so you may ask how will you know that the Betfair SP will fall below 3.00 before the race goes off? Well, the answer is to use the Betfair SP option when placing a bet or consider using some form of betting bot that allows you to input your required SP value.

All selections are published every day around 11.30 a.m. They also offer Bonus tips each day on the site, but they have asked us not to take those into account for the purpose of the review.

They publish an email address to deal with any customer service issues and claim to answer all member emails within 24 hours. They certainly answered my email questions with an almost immediate response, so no complaints there then!

They also recommend that everybody should use a staking plan and bank. They recommend a betting bank of at least 50 times your stake. e.g. if your chosen stake is £10 then a £500 betting bank should be more than enough to cope with losing bets which inevitably occur. The aim is to make a consistent profit over time, ending each month in profit. This is the simplest staking plan and the one they recommend for all new members. They suggest that once your betting bank starts to grow, you can increase your stakes accordingly. You can then assess your rate of progress and increase your stake in proportion. They recommend that you do this monthly.

For the purposes of this review they have requested that we use 2 staking plans – Level Stakes at £100 and Fixed Liability at £100. Our betting bank will therefore have to start at £5,000 (50 times the £100 level stake).

Dream Lays subscriptions are monthly, quarterly or annual, with a sliding scale of price depending on how long you sign up for. The monthly ticket is £59, the quarterly £139, and the annual price is £399. Dream Lays is sold via Clickbank so you are covered by the standard 60 day money back guarantee.

I am starting the review with effect from 1st July. The initial review will last for 56 “betting days”, with the option to extend to 84 “betting days”. I will try and update the service every few days, but please bear with me if there are the occasional gaps, as it normally means that I am travelling somewhere and cannot access the Internet easily.

Please let me know if you need any further information about the service and I look forward to testing it out on your behalf.

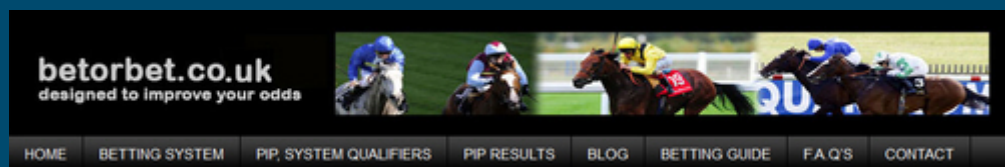

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Partners In Profit Introduction

Sergeant Steve Introduces Partners In Profit

Hi Bloggers,

Sgt Steve here, I have previously done reviews on LTO for Sports Betting Professor and Racing Tipsters and more recently Place Bet Pro, Cricket Tipster and Golf Betting Profits. I am the guy who has been late at posting consistently but I am determined to remedy that (though not off to a flyer this time!). Anyway, my name is Steve and I'm 42 years old and live in Melbourne, Australia. I have been interested in betting on horses for over 20 years now and have picked up sports betting as well in the past 5 or so years. I started doing sports arbitrage full time about 6 years ago and then moved to the UK and was trading horse racing for a couple of years. Back in Australia now and am still betting in my spare time and follow a couple of systems that seem reasonably good but haven't yet led me to the Holy Grail, betting being my source of income, which is my ultimate goal. Well my ultimate goal is to get my golf handicap into single figures but you get the gist, one thing follows another.

On to the real introduction, Partners In Profit NH version was originally being reviewed by Inspector Nige on LTO, regrettably he fell seriously ill at the Day 22 stage of the review and the last I heard he was in hospital so I wish him a speedy recovery. So what is Partners In Profit? – it is run by Phil Eadie and promoted by the Betorbet website. ('designed to improve your odds') and is a backing system, or two actually, one that focuses on National Hunt and one for the Flat. This will be a review run in two parts, or split, with a separate focus on each medium. There is a manual for each system but the selections are available on the Partners in Profit website and a reminder email is sent everyday, which makes things reasonably simple.

I will start with a \$1000 bank and be having \$10 win bets on all selections, therefore a 100 point bank. The manual recommends a 50 point bank and I am only using 100 as it is standard for these reviews.

So you don't actually have to know anything about horse racing to place these 'winning bets'. Also there is a 100% 60 day money back guarantee if you are not satisfied with these product. The cost is £37 for the NH system and £67 for the Flat, with a daily email service £17 and £25 per month respectively.

Anyway, on with the show!

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Betting Bubbles – Final Review



Sgt Rob Reviewing Betting Bubbles

This is the final review for Betting Bubbles...for information about the service, please refer to the introduction post [here](#)

The review covered 84 betting days over a 90 day period (due to 6 days of no bets)...it started on 25/02/2012 and finished on 24/05/2012.

The Financial Stuff

A 50 pt betting bank was advised and I used 1 pt to equate to £10 stakes.

At the end of the review, the 50 pt bank had swelled to 198.75 pts meaning a profit using stakes advised of 148.75 pts.

I also conducted a level stakes review...whilst this wasn't requested by the vendor, we try and do it here on BST as it can be a handy comparison for our other final reviews.

Starting with a 100 pt bank and betting 1 pt stakes, this bank ended up at 112.52 pts, a profit of 12.52 pts.

Statistics

Bets were advised using bookmakers only...no exchange betting was advised...for some of the selections, a slightly higher price could be obtained on the exchanges, but not enough to cause a major increase in the profit obtained via bookmakers.

15 bookmakers were used : Bet 365, Bet Victor, Bet Fred, Bet Win, Blue Square, Bodog, BoyleSports, Coral, Ladbrokes, Paddy Power, Sky Bet, Sporting Bet, Stan James, Tote Sport and William Hill.

In total, 132 bets were advised over 5 sports : Football, Golf, Premier League Darts, Rugby Union and Rugby League (I started off keeping the two Rugby codes separate and never merged them back together).

The 132 bets used a total stake of 716 pts and as mentioned above, generated a profit of 148.75 pts.

A quick breakdown for you to peruse :

Each bet was to be advised using a stake of between 1 and 10 pts...we never received any 1 pt or 9 pt stakes, but here is a breakdown of the bets by the other stakes :

Thoughts On Golf

There were 32 golf bets advised...these generally fell into 2 different types – 1) Win or each way betting on a named golfer in the overall tournament betting or 2) Bets on a player to win a 3 ball and the like.

From option 1 above there were 24 bets with 23 losers – the one exception being Luke Donald who gained us 75 pts when he won after being advised 5 pts each way at 12/1.

In total for the golf, 32 bets (9 winners) were advised using stakes of 155 pts for an overall profit of 39.41 pts. However, if you were to ignore the option 1 bets (e.g. concentrate on option 2 and 3 ball betting etc), even though you would lose the Donald return, the golf statistics now become 8 winning bets out of 8 with 52 pts outlayed to return 57.41 pts.

By doing this, you would have chopped 24/132 bets (18.18%) and saved on your pts outlay by 14.39% having trimmed 716 pts down to 613 pts.

Just something I noticed and maybe food for thought...

Other Thoughts

The lowest our bank reached during the trial was on 07/03 when it was at 38.57 pts, meaning a cumulative profit/loss at the time of -11.43 pts. By 10/03 it had clawed it's way back into positive territory before dipping back to negativity on 11/03.

12/03 was a no-bet day and on 13/03, Luke Donald was advised to win the Transitions Championship – and did so – meaning our profit/loss after that event stood at +72.47 pts and started increasing from there.

In terms of losing streaks, from 03/03 to 08/03 (which comprised of 5 betting days due to 1 no-bet day), we staked 46 pts for a return of -26.45 pts. And from 25/04 to 29/04 we staked 55 pts for a return of -45 pts.

In terms of winning streaks, as mentioned, the golf win of +75 pts was outstanding and from 19/04 to 24/04 we staked 46 pts for a profit of +38.57 pts.

In terms of how much was being staked, the biggest daily stakes occurred on : 11/03 (20 pts from a bank that stood at 51.72 pts), 21/03 (20 pts from a bank of 143.97 pts) and 31/03 (21 pts from a bank that stood at 117.93 pts).

Staking And Money Management

You are advised to use a bank of 50 pts. Common sense dictates the more you bet, the more you win. So with our final profit of +148.75 pts, at equating £10 to 1 pt (as I did during the review) means a profit over the 84 betting days of £1487.50

A quick table can show the effects of using different stakes – profit is calculated by multiplying stake by the overall profit of 148.75 pts – it does not include the subscription cost to the service.

At higher stakes, things look very tasty indeed, but you need to be able to ensure you can get your bets on. At £100 per point, a 5 pt each way bet on Luke Donald to win a golf tournament equates to £500 each way but you need to consider if the bookie in question will take the bet.

Somewhere near the start of this review, I also mentioned that we used 15 different bookmakers. This means that there may be some money floating around in cyberspace (where they debit your card instantly but can only credit it in 2 or 3 working days).

The Final Rating

I've been umming and aahing about this for a while now. The review period generated a profit of +148.75 pts in 84 betting days...as a standalone fact I think that could merit a rating of 4 stars.

But at times there has been a little element of a rollercoaster ride...staying in for the whole ride did prove to have it's benefits though.

I will pass this and award Betting Bubbles 3.5 stars

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Cricket Tipster – Final Review

Insp Steve Reviewing Cricket Tipster

Hi Bloggers,

To recap, Cricket Tipster is a product from a bloke called Anth Raine, who claims he is a “disillusioned ex Ladbrokes manager who uses inside knowledge to profit big (Classic tale of gamekeeper turns poacher)”.

Cricket Tipster is a tipping service for cricket which has regular email advice (pretty much daily for the duration of this review) and backup information via a members area on the website (which I never used, the tips always arrive in the inbox with upwards of 12 hours to spare). This system is simple to use and claimed to consistently finds winners at 7/2 and over.

There is a 100% money back guarantees if you are not satisfied with the product with a cost of £7 for the first month and £37 per month thereafter.

So altogether there were 200 bets, 70 winners, 127 losers ad 3 ties for a strike rate of 35 per cent. 222.5 points were staked for a return of 257.3 points, a profit of 34.8 points (this differs slightly from the Day 84 report as when I was compiling these stats I had made a couple of errors along the way).

So therefore, using a point value of \$100 the total amount staked would have been \$22,205 for a return of \$25,730, a return on investment of around 15.9 per cent, which is not to be sneezed at in the current economic climate!

The good thing about Cricket Tipster is that it doesn't require a huge starting bank and is designed for level staking though there could be some merit in using a percentage bank staking system going forward as if this performance repeats it will build up nicely. I rate this product 3.5 stars.

Soccer Betting Oracle – the service now managed by Winninginformationnetwork – is available on two access plans: 28 days plan for £54.00 and 90 days for £118.80 GBP. The service is provided by a professional soccer bet informants aimed at giving accurate and precise predictions.

After 84 betting days review the results are good and almost double the bank on recommended staking plan. Here are the results and statistics.

Recommended staking plan – 200 points and X point on stake:

Last period of soccer tips was a kind of hard one but I think the cause is the fact that almost all major leagues were coming to a close. Overall Soccer Betting Oracle made money and on £10 per point to the recommended staking plan the profit was over 1500 pounds on 84 days which more than covered the cost of the service and still left a healthy profit.

Three and half stars I think is a fair rating for Soccer Betting Oracle service.

League Table of Reviews

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A reasonable way of comparing the performance of systems is to work out the profit (or loss) as a percentage of the starting bank. Obviously this table doesn't replace reading the reviews, because *profit as %age of bank* is not the only factor in judging a system. Nevertheless, it is a valid at-a-glance way of bringing the mass of data together.

The league table now includes systems that have finished their reviews as well. At the moment it only includes systems that have recently finished but I will look to add more next month.

We have seventeen reviews that have made a profit of over 15%.
