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Football Bets Introduction



Sgt Chris Introduces Football Bets

Hi Bloggers,

This is my third review for Betting System Truths, and this time we're going to deal with a service promising to make profits from soccer betting. While I have read about many different football gurus, I find this one very interesting. And the reason is that the person behind the Football Bets service, Phil Brown, is an ex football odds compiler who was working for the bookies but thankfully now is on our side.

Surely, having a long term experience over the art of creating the right odds can be a great assistance to get the edge over the bookies and spot real value bets. I'm hoping Phil will do just that during our review period to make it a successful one.

Now, to cut to the chase, Football Bets it's a tipping service, dealing with soccer bets only, no other sports betting involved here. Most of the tips will be for the UK Leagues, but not only as Phil intends to find value for us from another league (France, Spain or Germany, etc.).

The tips are received via e-mail but additionally there's a special members area, where you can log in and have a look at the author's advices. Phil sends his e-mail whenever there's action, and this can happen either in the morning or the night before, giving us the time to place our bets. Furthermore, he explains what's the best odds we can find for our bet and which bookie to use. So, it's vital to keep accounts with many online bookies, otherwise it will be difficult if not impossible to achieve the best odds available.

For anyone willing to try the Football Bets service, the cost is just £1 for a two week trial. Beyond that period to become a full subscriber, the monthly fee is £34.99, and until now it's the only paying option.

If everything goes as plan, this review will last for 12 weeks and then see what happens. Normally, I will be updating the review each betting day or at least each week unless of course anything unscheduled comes up.

Last, but not least, is the staking plan we will follow for our review. I've had a brief discussion with the vendor, and he informed me there's no "official" staking plan because he thinks every customer has its own unique betting attitude, and i respect his opinion. However, he did propose three different ways, which will follow here:

1. Level stakes (our own traditional way, and the best one to compare any service/system)

2. Advised stakes (for every tip the author also provides his advised stake points)

3. A rolling bank with stakes set at X% of bank and recalculated in £ terms at end of each day. I will make that X% a 2% of the bank, making it a more aggressive approach.

For each staking plan, our starting bank will be 100 pts, helping to make a more straightforward comparison.

That's all for now, and i hope everything will go as plan. Feel free to ask anything you want about the service.

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Smart Soccer Trading – Introduction

Hi Bloggers,

Smart Soccer Trading is relative new on the market and the product is from Steve Davidson stable. Michael has put together a lot of trading strategies in order to operate on all type of matches.

As the name says this is a trading strategy collection split into three sections: Introduction, Gold and Premier.

First of all from all traders experience, discipline is the key, without discipline trading will cause big losses. Even if a strategy is low or high profit discipline will make the difference. The price for full package is 99.99 pounds and I consider this as a reasonable price for a full trading course.

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From the start I have looked at the selection strategies for trading matches. The videos present simple rules of selecting matches for trading and I consider this is the way to start. This is a crucial point on a trading day with the matching selections, expectation of bookies for that matches and personal analysis.

Perfect trading does not normally involve the full soccer match, in most cases before the finish the trade has been completed and a profit secured or stop loss strategy has kicked in to make the losses as low as possible. Yes, the second important thing in trading is stop loss strategy. Without stop loss strategy or a cover bets strategy huge losses can hit the trading bank.

Before i present all these packages I want announce that the intro is for non trading user or for beginners in trading. I consider this is the right way to present Smart Soccer Trading, because the goal of this product is to offer a complete trading package from start to complex trading strategies.

Smart Soccer Trading Introduction Package – covers the basics before trade successfully and the price is at £29.99.

1. How To Plan Your Trading Day
2. Trading Software
3. How To Use Auto Calculate an what if features.
4. Football Calendar
5. Liquidly Issues
6. Which Websites to use
7. Horse Trading v Soccer Trading
8. Factors that Influence Soccer (beyond your control).
9. Understanding Different Soccer Market (within the same game).
10. Maximize your Profit, Minimize your Losses
11. Understanding Asian Handicap
12. Lay the Draw & Correct Score Trading Strategy

These strategies have 2 hour and 30 minutes of video content explaining steps before the trade. As I said the discipline is the key and the package start with planning the trading day. Not every day is a trading one. Trading is all about liquidity and the match must be selected from high liquidity markets. Also there are a lot of infos about trading, factors, site to use, trading software and one trading strategy.

Smart Soccer Trading Gold Package – this is stage 2 and content 7 trading strategies and the price is at £59.99 and include the intro.

1. Under 2.5 goal and first Goal Market.
2. Buying High & Selling Low
3. Halftime 0-0 and Fulltime 0-0
4. Halftime 0-0 and Fulltime 0-0 (with a stop loss)
5. Halftime Score Market, with under 2.5 if scoreline is 0-0
6. Halftime Score Market, with under 2.5 if scoreline is 0-1(with goal)
7. Lay The Draw & Cover All Draws

This 80 minute package not only presents trading strategies but also gives exit strategies for each when the game moves against.

Smart Soccer Trading Premier – comes with another 6 strategies and the price is £99.99 and includes gold and intro.

1. Any Unquoted Correct Score Strategy

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2. Any Unquoted Correct Score Strategy with safeguard.
3. Under 2.5, and Correct Score markets
4. Underdog leading at halftime
5. Both Teams to Score & Correct Score
6. First Goal 0-10 Minutes

I'll use for this review only one bank of 1000 points. The videos presents trades with small value trades in order to show that trading can be started with a low bank around 500. Trading normally requires a lot of time, and for success this is a full time job. This package takes the user from beginning to full time job if the user wants this. Of course trades can be made few times on a week and this is great if profit comes.

The review will be for 8 weeks, and maybe will be an extended period if will be necessary. I'll try to cover all strategies in these 8 weeks. As I said strategies are used on certain conditions.

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The Laying Game – Final Review

Sergeant John Reviews The Laying Game

Rating: ★★★★★

I originally planned to review this system for 56 days but actually looked at it for nearly twice that time. One of the reasons I did that was the The Laying Game software, which literally does all the selection work for you, was upgraded a number of times, with some surprising results. I just needed to let the last version have a good run before finalising this review.

Although the software is ready to use by 3am, I scanned the tips in at 5am, noted their price on Betfair, then repeated the process at 10am, deleting any that were too high.

For the first 45 days the software was selecting anything from two to 10 tips, some of which fell by the wayside due to the nag being pricey or a non-runner (this was the case throughout the review). In that time there were 244 tips that ran, at prices below 5.1, with only 37 losses, making a profit of 125.5 points. The peak, however, came earlier on Day 38 when the profit was 235.35 points, an average daily profit of 6.19 points. Then there was an upgrade...


What the upgrade did was cut down the number of final selections and for the next 45 days the final daily tips only went above two on five occasions. This time there were 74 tips and 18 losses, resulting in an overall profit of 199 points, but only 73.5 points on the second period.

During this period there was another upgrade, but myself and many others were not informed, resulting in new purchasers of the product blogging that they were scanning way more tips. I contacted Steve Davidson, the author, who sent me the link and we were back on track.

The software title has always been called The Laying Game, UK, but following the first upgrade an overlay was imprinted on the title: **NEW 2012**. The final version certainly gave us more selections, but many of the race meetings scanning across the top of the box were far from UK. Irish racing was now being selected on a regular basis, but although South African, French and USA races were being scanned, none of the latter turned up on the final list.

The final lap of the review was far from auspicious. The last 17 days produced 75 final selections, one more than the last 45-day period, but 24 losses, six more than the last period. This finalised the review profit at 148.54 points, 86.71 points less than when it peaked, but still not to be sniffed at. Any system that can produce a daily average of around two points and an 80% strike rate has merits, but it does involve quite a bit of work to get there.

Simple as the selections are to scan, they still have to be processed, layed (with currently an outlay averaging between 20 and 30 points), but for the cost of £29.99 for the year, it's a bargain.

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Trainer Track Stats – Final Review

ADMIN NOTE – PLEASE DON'T CONFUSE THIS WITH THE WINTER JUMPS TRAINER TRACK STATS THAT HAS JUST BEEN RELEASED AND IS THE PRODUCT THAT JAMES HAS FOLLOWED FOR SEVERAL YEARS

I started writing this final review of Gavin Priestley's Trainer Track Stats underneath a chart showing its successes since 2006-2007. An average profit of over 62 points per year in that time is very impressive, even more so when you multiply that by £20, the figure the statistics are based on, which makes an average £1240 a year. Let us not forget that those results were for an entire year, not for a six-month period that I have just reviewed. During the last six months I will show that at one stage the service was losing 175.56 points, that is a loss of £3511.20 based on the services statistics.

So should we be aiming for around a 30-point profit during this review? Maybe so, but the final figures showed a profit in the flat racing of 0.14 of a point and a loss of 7.56 points in the National Hunt results.

I am not privy to a breakdown of results over the two periods of the years previous, but if I was paying out for this service there would have been a gnashing of teeth after the first two months this year when there were only four wins from 26 selections, resulting in a 46.49 points loss.


Assuming the toothless punter had stuck to the task, he would have been well rewarded when the National Hunt tips started appearing two days later and kicked off with a win on the second tip. In fact, after five NH tips it peaked with a profit of 47.83 points on Day 74, but with the Flat racing suffering a 59.28-points loss.

Overall the punter was probably happy with the final analysis for the Trainer Track Stats, but at no stage was his bank better off than on the 80th day, when the two disciplines made a combined profit of 1.31 points. For the following 30 days the small profit became a distance memory as results plummeted to the massive loss described in the opening paragraph of this review. I must say that following this fall results picked up appreciably with 16 winning days to just fall short of breaking even at the close, but I cannot help feeling that the disgruntled investor would have thrown themselves upon their sword long before this.

I had no problems with the way the service ran during these six months. I picked up the selections by logging into the website and only a couple of times the information had not been updated, but an email was soon answered.

It sometimes did get frustrating when there were no tips. From the 163 betting days 72 had no selections, but when they were forthcoming they averaged over two a day.

The £39 price tag for the Trainer Track Stats service is a reasonable one and the admin of the organisation first class, but let us put these results behind us Mr Priestley, the last six months have been an unmitigated disaster.



Admin Note

We have been contacted by the vendor, Gavin Priestley, as he was not happy with our Final Review. Gavin did make a valid point that we didn't make it clear that the review was based on staking 5 points per selection, even though that is the staking that has been in use for all 164 days of the review, for which we held our hands up straight away and offered to add that to the review. Gavin also questioned the scale of the maximum loss so we asked that he confirm that to us so that again we could correct that if it was wrong. As we've heard nothing back from Gavin on that we will assume that the figures are correct. So to confirm that where John quotes profit/loss figures he is using £100 stakes because he started with a

£5000 bank.

Where non standard stakes are used we normally quote the final profit/loss to 1 point level stakes, which we didn't do for this final review. So the final figures based on 1 point level stakes was that the Flat racing made a profit of 0.03 points and the National Hunt made a loss of 1.51 points and so an overall loss of 1.48 points. To help clarify some of the other figures quoted in this Final Review using 1 point level stakes the loss during the first 2 months was only 9.30 points and the loss for the 30 days following the high point at day 80 was 35.11 points so anybody using the advised £20 stake on a £1000 start bank would only have lost £702.20.

None of this changes the rating of this Final Review and it is still Failed but we hope that has cleared things up for anyone. Having said that it doesn't change our view that Trainer Track Stats is a worthwhile addition to anybodys betting portfolio as it has made steady profits for the last 6 years and while the summer version hasn't performed well this year there is no reason to suspect that it or the winter version won't perform well in the future.

Win Master Pro Review Summary



Hi Bloggers

It is now two week since I posted questions on the membership site to which I have not received any reply. So I have decided that as the system sellers cannot be bothered to provide any level of customer service I will terminate the review. Additionally, the sales page has not been updated to reflect the changed staking plan.

I am not going to spend a lot of my time in writing up a full summary but suffice to say that Win Master Pro has failed to break even let alone make a profit. At level stakes the system lost £255.72 or just over 50% of the starting bank whilst the original and much hyped staking plan lost £385.75 or 77% of the starting bank.

Now that the membership site appears to have been abandoned, I cannot even suggest that these losses are just a "curse of the review" losing streak and certainly cannot recommend Win Master Pro as a system to be added to your portfolio.

Level stakes: £50 per bet / Staking Plan is % of bank increase in stake after losing bet

Strike Rate: 46% (64/139)

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League Table of Reviews

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A reasonable way of comparing the performance of systems is to work out the profit (or loss) as a percentage of the starting bank. Obviously this table doesn't replace reading the reviews, because *profit as %age of bank* is not the only factor in judging a system. Nevertheless, it is a valid at-a-glance way of bringing the mass of data together.

The league table now includes systems that have finished their reviews as well.

We have twenty six reviews that have made a profit of over 15%.
