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Dream Lays – Final Review Summary



Sgt Tony concludes his review of Dream Lays



Hi All

Introduction

As the name suggest, Dream Lays is a laying service provided by Keith and his team. The service only seeks to place lay bets when the odds of the recommended selections fall under 3.00 using the SP on Betfair.

Each day, there are ten or so selections, but these will not all turn into bets, as the SP odds will not always be under 3.00 on Betfair. They advise placing your bets in the ten minutes leading up to the off. This will not be practical for those of you who do not have access to bookies during the day, so you may ask how will you know that the Betfair SP will fall below 3.00 before the race starts? Well, the answer is to use the Betfair SP option when placing a bet or consider using some form of betting bot that allows you to input your required SP value.

All selections are published every day around 11.30 a.m. They also offer Bonus tips each day on the site, but they have asked us not to take those into account for the purpose of the review.

They publish an email address to deal with any customer service issues and claim to answer all member emails within 24 hours. They certainly answered my email questions with an almost immediate response, so no complaints there then!

They also recommend that everybody should use a staking plan and bank. They recommend a betting bank of at least 50 times your stake. e.g. if your chosen stake is £10 then a £500 betting bank should be more than enough to cope with losing bets which inevitably occur. The aim is to make a consistent profit over time, ending each month in profit. This is the simplest staking plan and the one they recommend for all new members. They suggest that once your betting bank starts to grow, you can increase your stakes accordingly. You can then assess your rate of progress and increase your stake in proportion. They recommend that you do this monthly.

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For the purposes of this review they have requested that we use 2 staking plans – Level Stakes at £100 and Fixed Liability at £100. Our betting bank will therefore have to start at £5,000 (50 times the £100 level stake).

Dream Lays subscriptions are monthly, quarterly or annual, with a sliding scale of price depending on how long you sign up for. The monthly subscription costs is £59, the quarterly price is £139, and the annual price is £399.

The review period ran from 1st July to 24th September to ensure that we got the full 84 betting days.

Results

I started the review with a bank of £5,000 for each system. I finished the review with a bank of £4,260 for the £100 Level Stakes plan giving us a loss of £740 for the review period. The £100 Fixed Liability plan finished with a bank of £4,187.10 giving us a loss of £812.90 for the review period.

Over the period of the review there were 609 selections of which 323 were winning lays and 286 were losing lays – a 53% strike rate.

Recommended £100 liability staking plan:

Start Balance: £5,000.00

Total P/L: –£812.90

Final Balance: £4,187.10

Recommended £100 Level Stakes plan:

Start Balance: £5,000.00

Total P/L: –£740.00

Final Balance: £4,260.00

Although both staking plans produced a loss, at one stage the £100 Level Stakes plan was nearly £1,900 in profit and the £100 Fixed Liability plan was nearly £1,700 in profit. The downfall of the system is the fact that a few of the losing runs made very large losses, which the system struggled to recoup quickly. September was a particularly poor month and had the review been a month earlier, it may well have produced a profit. I also feel that the judicious monitoring of the real time results, with some form of 'stop loss' or 'maximum loss per day' in place, would have resulted in certain profits.

Impressions

It was really use to use this system. The selections are posted on the website every day in plenty of time for the day's racing. I think that the service would be better if Keith also sent out a daily email, as that would give subscribers the best of both worlds.

The support was excellent and my questions (sometimes dumb ones!) were answered quickly and efficiently. My only slight criticism is that the results are not always updated as quickly as they might be. In fairness, this is more of a problem to the reviewer than the subscriber, as I just wanted to check my results with his!

Whilst Dream Lays scores highly for ease of use & support it didn't make a profit and so it goes into the failed category.

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Little Acorns Final Review

Little Acorns is a low-liability laying formula that uses low stakes to grow bigger banks and be in the position of being confident to increase your stakes as the bank increases.

The system has been developed by Andrew David, who is confident that your betting balance will increase between seven and 35 times each month, without exposing yourself to high liabilities.

For this review I used two-point stakes to comply with Betfair's minimum stake requirements and each review day referred to actual days when there was a selection.

I also took the decision to find selections each morning as opposed to the "five to ten minutes before race time" as suggested by the author. Generally the morning selections held up at race time, but there is no doubt that there were possible selections that I missed by not sitting in front of the computer all afternoon.

This is where I have a problem with Little Acorns in as much that I am of the firm belief that most punters have neither the means nor the inclination to sit for long hours in the hope they might find one or two tips during the day. So the results listed here were all found and layed in the morning with no hanging around.

The review lasted 22 weeks, which is important when assessing whether or not the cost of the system is justified when analysing the income.

There is a Level Stake option plus two recovery stake plans – the Adding Loss method and the Fibonacci sequence. Level stakes could probably be judged as the 'safe' method, particularly by those of us who shy away from recovery plans, but in this instance it made the least amount of profit, although all three made points.

Level Stakes made 19.71 points (9.85 points if using a one-point stake) so if you were using a five-pound note for each bet it would take about 11 months to make enough to cover the payment for the £97 system fee based on a one-point stake. Little Acorns is a one-off payment, so for that figure you could clear the fee and go on to make a slow but steady income.

The Adding Loss method involved adding the basic stake to the last points loss following a defeat. This made a little more profit; 25.92 points (12.96 points if using a one-point stake). This performed well if the losing runs were short compared to the Fibonacci sequence which made 39.35 points (19.68 points if using a one-point stake) and accomplished more when the losing runs were greater, but was by far the most profitable. Even so one has to consider the greater investment when multiplying stakes to recover losses, although they did work.

The longest losing run was five and the highest winning sequence was nine.


The chart below illustrates better than words and you can see the steady progress of Level Stakes compared to the sharp dips and troughs of the other two with their seemingly inevitable recovery.

The total number of selections was 128 with 67 of them being layed successfully, a 52% strike rate. Taking the top staking system (Fibonacci), which made 19.68 points using a one-point stake; this produced a return on investment of 15.38.

I found the selections easy to find. There is neither complicated formula nor pages of form guides to scan. Simply open up Betfair and check each race for an odds-on favourite together with a trio of further parameters that are within easy grasp. I believe I proved that scanning through Betfair during the morning can still be profitable, although you will find even more selections by watching the betting ten minutes before the off.

You can see from the chart that, apart from a couple of dips from defeats early in the review, none of the staking methods made an overall loss since and the system confirmed its claim that “your betting balance will increase between seven and 35 times each month, without exposing yourself to high liabilities.”

I think this system is an ideal addition to the portfolio of any serious punter and has my highest recommendation.

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League Table of Reviews

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A reasonable way of comparing the performance of systems is to work out the profit (or loss) as a percentage of the starting bank. Obviously this table doesn't replace reading the reviews, because *profit as %age of bank* is not the only factor in judging a system. Nevertheless, it is a valid at-a-glance way of bringing the mass of data together. The league table now includes systems that have finished their reviews as well. We have twenty seven reviews that have made a profit of over 15%.
