No1 Lay System - Reviewer Sgt Dave

Rating: ★★☆☆☆

Hi Blogger's

Before we start I will say that I have 4 more selections and one loser more than the SWP websites results the reason for this is non runners, due to time difference I had to place the bets early for the evening racing although I can put odds ranges in, I have no way of taking in account non runners on the bots I use. The same scenario would apply to those of you working during the day that place your bets before going to work, so I think it is a relevant factor, but to be fair to the system I have included the figures if you had accounted for late non runners.

What can I say about no 1 lays well up to Friday 22nd it was going well albeit very slowly the system had just 1 losing lay from 27 selections and a profit of 17.70 points, nothing to shout about for nearly 3 months of betting but a profit nonetheless, then bang it got 3 selections on the day and one was a loser at 12.41 which made a big hole in the profits. Now after 84 days it is left with just + 8.19 points and although it is a profit it is not much to show but because it has not made a large loss like some of its SWP I can hardly fail and jail it, I certainly cannot pass and recommend it (more on this later) so I am left with putting it in neutral which I find hardly ideal because I prefer things to be cut and dried if possible.

I did extend the review to 84 days hoping that I would be able to make a definite final decision unfortunately it did not happen. Anyway I will quickly run a few numbers:

Working To odds Of 2.00 to 17.00 (Review)

Taking in Account Late Non Runners

Selections 24/ Winning Lays 23 = Strike Rate of 95.84%
Profit 10.44 points
Average Price of Selection 11.82 (estimated)
Average Price of Losing Lay 12.41
Longest Winning Run 21
Longest Losing Run 1

Now lets compare them with my standard benchmark which is my trusted lay system Betfair Miracle using my version of only backing main bets and bonus bets which are also main.

Betfair Miracle(Sgt Dave's Version)

August 2nd to October 24th inclusive

Selections 65/60 Winning Lays = Strike Rate 92.31%
Profit 28.34 points
Average Price of Selections 6.59
Average Price of Losing Lay 6.732
Longest Winning Run 29
Longest Losing Run 4

As we can see the review version of No 1 Lays can not compete with BFM even if you doubled the selections you would not be able to get near the 28.34 points. If you take the websites result which takes into account the non runners then the profit per runners is not bad but you would probably die of boredom waiting for the selections. The Any odds part actually surpassed BFM but would you want to gamble on laying horses up to 170+ in price I know I wouldn't.

Conclusion

This system does do what it says on the tin it is a selective system and does deliver a very high rate strike rate and make a profit; it is also easy to use. The problem is that we did not get 15 to 20 selections per month as mentioned on the website, the average price of our loser or

losers depending on whether you follow the review or the website results both are a lot higher than 7.17 mentioned on the sales page. It could be that with the winter months approaching it may get more selections and then we would have more numbers to crunch. Also taking into consideration the system costs 125 pounds and they want to charge 40 pounds for the tipping service, compare that to BFM which is under 100 and half the price per month for its e-mail service it is not really very good value. For those of you working during the day and placing your bets before going to work or during your lunch break may find problems with the non runners taking it below the minimum or finding races qualifying that had too many runners when you placed your bets but qualifying later in the day, this is what happened to me.

You also have the issue of how many people would be comfortable laying horses around the 17.00 mark not many I bet. So in conclusion I would say it is too risky and too expensive to buy, but I cannot fail it as it made a profit also it is the only SWP product that I have tested that has actually finished in front. We also need more selections so as to judge it better, so all things considered I will place it in neutral.

Racing Personality

I thought that this time that we would have a more up to date personality and that is the iron man himself and hopefully BBC Sports Personality of the Year in 2010:

Anthony Peter McCoy OBE (born 4 May 1974), commonly known as **A. P. McCoy** or **Tony McCoy**, is a Northern Irish horse racing jockey, widely regarded, based on his career wins, as the finest jump jockey to date.



Having recorded his first win at age 17 in 1992, by 2009 he had ridden over 3,000 winners and been named British jump racing Champion Jockey every year since 1995/6. His winners included the prestigious Cheltenham Gold Cup, Champion Hurdle, Queen Mother Champion Chase, King George VI Chase and the 2010 Grand National, at his fifteenth attempt.

McCoy was appointed MBE in the 2003 Queen's Birthday Honours and OBE in the 2010 Birthday Honours for his services to horse racing.

The Story

The Ulster-born Tony McCoy began his career in horseracing in Ireland at an early age, riding his first winner in 1992 at the age of 18. Success in Ireland led to a move across the Irish Sea and Tony McCoy earned his English racing license in 1994.

Tony McCoy made a strong impression in his very first season in English National Hunt racing. The determined jockey rode 74 winning horses in his first season. The following season he racked up 253 victories in all races, setting a new National Hunt record. Unsurprisingly this achievement earned him the Champion Jockey title for that year, and he has not conceded it to another jockey since.

Two seasons into his English National hunt career, Tony McCoy won his first Cheltenham Festival Top Jockey title, riding three winners at the 1997 Cheltenham Festival. In that year Tony McCoy achieved a rare Cheltenham Festival double with wins in both the Cheltenham Gold Cup and the Champion Hurdle on Mr Mulligan and Make a Stand.

In 1998 Tony McCoy, Cheltenham Festival legend, achieved his second Top Jockey title when he won a triumphant five races, although he failed to clinch the Cheltenham Gold Cup. In the next two years his record breaking continued, as he amassed wins by the hundred, breaking Sir Gordon Richard's record for winners in a season in 2002 with a remarkable haul of 289 wins in both National Hunt and Flat racing.

Tony McCoy's successes on the race track did not come without cost. The jockey is known for his unrelenting riding style that sees him push horses to their limits, and has suffered severe injuries on a number of occasions. McCoy even claims that he has broken nearly every bone in his body during his career. He is retained by the Irish millionaire and avid horse-owner, J. P. McManus, and normally rides for the ex-jockey Jonjo O'Neill's stable. McCoy can often be noticed riding a McManus horse by the owner's distinctive green and gold hooped jersey, often with a white cap.

Having won the Cheltenham Gold Cup, Champion Hurdle, Queen Mother Champion Chase and King George VI Chase, McCoy had few targets left to chase, the most notable outstanding targets being to ride 300 winners in a season, and to win the Grand National and that he achieved this year on Don't Push It, trained by Jonjo O'Neill and owned by J. P. McManus at the fifteenth attempt. The nearest McCoy had previously come in the National were three third-place finishes, in 2001 and 2002 aboard Martin Pipe's Blowing Wind (as the 8-1 favourite in 2002), and in 2006 on Jonjo O'Neill's 5-1 joint favourite, Clan Royal. In 2009 he finished 7th on Butler's Cabin, which started as 7/1 favourite so that was one of his targets achieved.

Retirement

Highly unlikely yet as he says he never stops dreaming of the day he'll reach 4000, also he want to achieve his other target of 300 winners in a season, who is to say that he will not reach these given his dedication and iron will.

What Makes Him Special ?

Here are some of the comments from trainers etc:

He's a man of great riding talent, and along with that he has a will to win. That's what separates him from most of the others.

He likes portraying himself as a miserable bugger, which he isn't. Behind it all he has a marvelous sense of the ridiculous, which you have to have if you are stupid enough to be involved in jump racing.

He's very dedicated and determined, he has got a racing brain, reads races well and can adapt to any changes.

He is very self-critical too. He schools differently to anyone else – he has so much confidence which helps the horses immeasurably.

He is a great rider in every way – very determined, very focussed – is a fabulous ambassador for the sport and is a terrific champion.

AP just goes on and on, and is the best there has ever been.

He rides all sorts of different horses – he rides good ones and bad ones – and you get the same AP in a seller as you do in the Gold Cup.

He's a great assessor of a horse. He rides and he tells you – you might not like it – but it's what he thinks, and that's what I love about him, because you know where you are going and you can plan your horse.

And from the punters side at least when he is on board you know he will never stop trying to get the horse to do its best and always wants to win what ever the meeting or the type of race, what more can you ask if you have risked your hard earned money on one of his mounts.
