INTRODUCTION

Of course we still have our weekly roundup covering 19 current reviews, Lay League Table, unfortunately this week nothing from you folks come on now! New Reviews

6 New Reviews this week and a bit of a mixed bag so we should have something of interest for everyone.

All Weather Backing System – Introduction - Reviewer Sgt Philip

Hi Bloggers

This system involves backing certain horses to win in particular all weather races at Lingfield, Wolverhampton and Southwell. Racing at Kempton is excluded from this system. The author states that historically the best months for the system are December through to February; however the system can be used all year round.

The horses selected will never be odds on and prices vary from 6/4 to 10/1, it is recommended not to back below or above these prices. If 2 horses are selected in the same race, both are backed, although the author says he cannot think of a time when there have been 2 selections in the same race. No races over 11 runners are included in the results, although non-runners on the day do count, therefore a 12 runner race, which has a non-runner on the day could possess a selection on that day.

The price? £45, So what do you get for your money – a 4 page PDF document, with no padding but simply a straight forward explanation of the system and how it operates. The system claims a 25% strike rate, which means that there will be losing runs, like any other system. I suspect that there may not be many selections and I have not found any in the last week, with this in mind I will be reporting results on the blog weekly. I intend to start with a £250 betting bank, using £10 stakes. The review will continue until April 2011.

Champion Draws – Introduction - Reviewer Sgt Tommy

Hi Bloggers,

No rest for the wicked!

So I start my latest review back on the old 'footie'. This will be a review of the latest service from the 'Champion Lays' team and we shall concentrate on- you guessed it... DRAWS!

There is currently a free trial with this service which will last until the 1st December. I have actually been watching the trial since the 24th October and will continue to report results from the 1st December.

The matches are emailed usually twice a week and are designated either 'A', 'B', 'C' or 'D' status depending on the previous results. We shall be betting from 9 major leagues around the world.

I will start with a bank of 100 pts and bet progressively as follows:

'A' bets - 3% of bank

'B' bets - 6% of bank

'C' bets - 9% of bank

'D' bets - 12 % of bank

Just to update you on the results so far from October 24th to November 21st.

Starting bank = **100 pts**

Current P/L = + **19.91 pts**

New bank = + **119.91 pts**

Daves Pro Golf Selections – Introduction - Reviewer RM Dave

Hi Bloggers

Something new for me to try this as the title indicates it is a Golf tipping service and is run by a chap called Dave Bicknell a professional golfer. So what can we expect from the service around 5 or 6 each way selections per major tournament (you normally have at least 2 tournaments per week) these are sent out by e-mail every Wednesday within the e-mail reasons

are given why each player has been chosen which is good thing. Now the tournaments start on a Thursday and finish on a Sunday sometimes they do overrun into Monday, one thing to be aware of now is that most of matches are being played in the eastern part of the world so be wary of the time difference. The selections are also available on a member's webpage in case you have a problem with your e-mail. So apart from the main E.W Bets, selections are also sent out during the 4 days for the 2 and 3 balls these could be win bets or lay bets. Looking at the profits shown on the website and sales page the service has made around 246 points profit in 6 months to 0.5 points E.W stakes given the nature of the sport and the size of the fields 160 plus sometimes, one will get losing runs but with odds of 50/1 or more being quite common it does not take long for any losses to be regained.

So the cost of the service is £47 per month, a bit of money can be saved if you subscribe for 6 months it will set you back £235 and for a full year the cost is £470. No recommendation is made for a bank so I will start off with 200 points Bank betting 1 point E.W per main selection and then I will separate the 2 and 3 ball selections using 1 point level stake starting with a 100 point Bank. So lets see what this review brings forth rather than call the trial by days it will be done by week I already have the selections from Wednesday the 17th so will be posting the first batch of results tomorrow.

Laying Low Odds – Introduction - Reviewer Sgt Thomas

Hi Constables,

I'm about to start reviewing a new laying system which promises to do what it says, i.e. lay at low odds.

The website is fairly basic and, refreshingly, makes no wild claims regarding results or winnings.

The results available are from August 1, 2010 to date and show a solid, if unremarkable performance with strike rates in excess of 70% each month and winnings of 5 – 10 points each month.

There are only 20 or so selections each month, updated on a member's only website daily, so you would have to risk fair amount per point to recoup your outlay for the service and make a reasonable profit.

This is a tipping service and costs £47 per month with the first month free and a further 60 day money back guarantee – giving you 3 months to trial the system at no cost. A very generous offer indeed, anyway on with the trial

Win and Place Investment Plan – Introduction - Reviewer Sgt Rich

Hi Constables

I'll be starting to review this Plan from Steve James (published by bettingsystem.info) on November 18th.

The sales page says it has increased a betting bank of £120 to over £6,000, since the start of 2010, and it produces the results for that period here: [\[Results\]](#) it should be noted that this increase uses a staking plan of increasing stakes by one point every time the bank has increased by the size of the original bank. This relatively aggressive staking plan is justified by the high success rate (75%). The results printed are for Staking Plan #2. Also it states the prices are Betfair prices, but the profit column does not take into account Betfair commission. Nevertheless taking 5% off the profit each time still shows an impressive increasing bank. When you buy the plan for £95 you get a Word document outlining the selection system and three suggested staking plans. I will report the progress of each staking plan and compare them to level stakes.

With the purchase you also get access to three months tipping service. This is useful, because although you can find the selections yourself using the steps outlined in the Word document,

phoning in or visiting the forum where the selections are advised will give you confidence that you are applying the selection criteria correctly. Also to work through the selection criteria yourself, you need to have access to either the printed copy of Racing Post or the online subscription copy of the Racing Post. (The free online Racing Post will not give you all the data you need). The online subscription to Racing Post is £17 per month or, if you prefer, you can continue with the tipping service after the first free three months, for £30 per month.

The selection procedure follows 7 easy rules and is well explained. My only gripe is that rule 6 says that “discretion” may be applied to back a horse even if it doesn’t fully meet rule 6 criteria. I don’t know if any of the reported results or the future advised tips include any of these discretionary selections, which adds a slight element of vagueness to the results. I’ll try to report how many of these crop up. So that’s another reason to follow the tipping service. For the purposes of this review we will follow the telephone/forum tips.

The 75% win rate is backed up by 92.4% of selections either winning or being placed. The results I will track will all be to Betfair SP with 5% deduction from profits.

Staking Plan #1 needs a recommended 32 point bank.

Staking Plan #2 needs a recommended 12 point bank for the win only bets. It needs a 6 point bank for place only bets.

Staking Plan #3 needs a recommended 42 point bank

For Level Stakes tracking I’ll start with a bank of 100 points with 1 point stakes.

That's right I am giving Betfair ATM 4.5 stars and recommending it!

Now before everyone starts jumping up and down, Betfair ATM came pretty damn close to getting 5 stars, oh well I here you cry how can you do that? It is because it is an education, its a strategy that can be used for years to come, it does make steady profit once you have mastered the techniques Betfair ATM uses Betfair so you're not going to get banned or have your account restricted. So let's cut to the chase and list those punters the Betfair ATM strategy will not suit:

If you want to get rich quick, don't buy Betfair ATM buy a lottery ticket and cross your fingers.

You want easy money expect something for nothing.

Do not want or can't put a couple of hours effort in per day.

Cannot spare time even at the weekend or in the evening.

Want selections handed to you on a plate.

Cannot think outside of the box.

Not interested in learning something new. Even if once learned will last you for many years.

Cannot focus on a subject for more than a few seconds, easily distracted.

Cannot keep a cool head or rational mind under pressure.

No patience to paper trade or back to very small stakes whilst undertaking the learning process.

Who would Betfair ATM suit anyone who has the opposite traits of the above!

So what is Betfair ATM?

It is a strategy that uses In Play running in the review I used Fairbot which is a much quicker interface than Betfair and allows you to use stakes under the 2 pound minimum, I also run 2 of these applications with a refresh of 1 second. The Betfair ATM PDF manual you purchase gives guidelines on how the author goes about the process, thankfully during the review

additional information was added at the end of the old manual giving more guidelines when to place a bet. Do not forget to incorporate these with the existing rules. Once again every race will be different and that's why trying to automate ATM will not work. When I first tried the strategy before going live I tried it on all races and found it difficult, the author told me to stick to races 1 mile or over, he also said that although it makes money on the flat it does a lot better on the jumps.

On the subject of the author I found him to be most helpful and e-mails were answered promptly, I was also able to do a live racing session with him as well. So after a few days I was starting to get the hang of it but found myself betting in races I normally avoid so reading through the guidelines I decide to add my own approach to it, also it gave me an idea of what races might qualify before the start of racing and to me the races chosen gave me a slight edge. Here were my additional rules for those who have not read my reviews

Races of 1 mile plus with 12 or less runners,

Exclude Selling, Auction and Claiming races.

Eliminate Amateur, Apprentice and Conditional races.

I also added extra time for additional furlongs and will also wait until the market clearly shows me that the horse is the selection now by doing the latter I may lose a slight edge on the price but I actually managed to increase the strike rate. When you have a busy weekend always favour jump racing try to see how competitive the fields are pick the lesser ones. So armed with my own slightly modified version of Betfair ATM how did I do over the 56 days of the review lets look at the stats.

Number of Selections 390/ Winning Bets 340 = Strike Rate of 87.18%

Profit 93.29 points (After 5% commission deducted)

Return on Investment 23.92% after deductions for commission and losses.

Average Price of Winning Bet = 1.4425

Number of Betting Days 55 out of 56

Number of Losing Days 4

Biggest Loss on one Day = 1.06 points (once)

Number of Winning Days = 51

Biggest win on one Day = 5.48 points (once)

Well a profit of 93.29 points on 55 days of betting actually computes to 1.70 points per day, I am sure as I got more experience I would have been on 2 or more points a day. My strike rate was actually higher at 87.18% but the author hits around 83/84% with an average of 1.45 odds so I was slightly lower on that at 1.4425. So as you can see once you have got the knowledge of this one the strike rate is good, longest losing run selection wise was 2 on just 1 day only. If you backed on the weekends only you would have made 26.56 points profit and one Saturday was missed, the strike rate for the weekends was approaching 85% so you really can use Betfair ATM anytime to suit.

Conclusion

If you are prepared to learn this well Betfair ATM will provide a steady source of income, also once you understand the In Play market you could lay or back to win or trade. With the In Play market you have to be focussed it is a fast moving environment if you're not sharp enough

you could get burnt. There are some players who mess the odds up you will get use to that I have seen horses at 1.7 to win suddenly go haywire out to like 8.00 for a few seconds then come flying back down to 1.6 it can be disconcerting at first. Stick to the jumps I find them a lot easier I do listen to timeform radio on flash mode that's the quickest, although the author does not recommend it. I listen out for horses that the pundits say will travel well that will not find anything at the business well worth avoiding, also front runners can be misleading a lot of time they do not make it home so it may pay to check if the course favours them or not. So here you have a strategy that can be adapted, can be used on weekends or evening only or everyday depending on your work commitments etc, downside you have to work hard with this one study the races make notes learn and once you are ready start off small with your stakes as you will still be learning for a while. From my point of view a very interesting and worth while product and I hope to get back to using it again once my job commitments have settled down. Currently Betfair ATM is selling for 67 pounds I consider that a very reasonable price for acquiring a new approach to betting that will serve you well for many years. Like all products from this stable the price will be going up to 87 quid but I feel a price tag around £300 would be better suited. IT truly is a masterpiece of knowledge.

So my 2nd failure of the week comes in the form of the 'Format Racing Method'.

I'm afraid the writing was on the wall for the Format Racing Method as early as the first week and at no time during the trial has this system EVER been in profit. The figures speak for themselves, with a starting bank of 100 pts, we have reached a P/L figure of **-66.33 pts** after 56 days. Not quite losing our bank but certainly heading that way.

Now I will again state that my figures were based on BSP and NOT on the 'live' prices just before the start of the race so there may well be certain differences small or large between my

figures and those who may have been betting 'live'. Since I have had no comments or feedback from the author or anyone else for that matter, I will assume that my figures are approximately correct.

There may well be something in the Format Racing Method even though it has proved unsuccessful this time around. A more detailed analysis of which types of races have been winning and which have been losing may provide some hope for future trials, but that is for the Format Racing Method author to decide upon or someone else who may have the dedication or inspiration to try to make something of the Format Racing Method.

So for the time being the 'Format Racing Method' is duly placed in the 'Failed' section.
