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Soccer Betting HQ – Introduction

11th October 2011



Inspector Josh introduces Soccer Betting HQ

Hi there, my name is Josh and I am new to this site. I am a student currently at university and have been trading for about a year now and I love every bit of it. I have been following certain reviews on Laytheodds and Bettingsystemtruths for some time now so I thought I would get involved and review some for myself. I hope you enjoy my posts and that this is a winning system. Good luck!

On to the system then. As the name suggests, this product involves betting on 'soccer', (or football), and it prides itself in betting in 'unconventional' ways. This is a system for trading rather than a simple tipping service. The package costs £69.95 which would appear to be on the more expensive side for what you are given, but we shall see. For your money, you are rewarded with a rather short but sweet 10 page e-book manual, which outlines 5 betting systems in very easy-to-follow bullet points. If the written word is too hard to follow (which is really unlikely as it is all very straightforward), there are short videos to accompany each system.

The *Soccer Betting HQ* systems themselves are all in-play trading techniques which have been carefully calculated and timed to ensure safe trading. Each system has a risk meter, with one system regarded as 'Moderate risk', three as 'Low risk' and one as 'Very low risk'. Each one also outlines the percentage of your betting bank it recommends using, the highest amount being 20% of your bank. There is not a recommended starting bank so I will create one myself – I will use five 100 point banks, one for each system so we can discover which is the most effective out of the five. Given the lack of starting bank advice, there does not seem to be any limitations with this service, i.e. anyone can use it. It should also not matter how many people use Soccer Betting HQ as it shouldn't affect the market negatively.

The systems all appear to aim for a profit margin of 5-15% each and there are a number of stop-loss methods outlined if things were to go wrong. Form and statistics are not necessary when selecting the games; it is purely mathematical and reacting to certain trends in the in-play markets. A couple of them have pre-match specifications which will require your attention before the match has kicked off. Many of the systems can be used in one game alone (in a perfect world) as they mostly occur at different intervals in the game. The first one operates in the opening 10 minutes. The second is a Lay the Draw technique 'with a twist'. Third and Fourth operate around the hour mark of a game. And the fifth is a dutching technique of correct scorelines.

My first impression of the Soccer Betting HQ system is that it is well set out and extremely easy to follow. My second impression, however, is that it might be hard to find games which qualify for the systems regularly. A big fixture list would be necessary to secure large profits I feel, so I will be looking to use this primarily on weekends and on midweek European evenings. A couple of the techniques appear to be just basic scalping (placing a bet and trading out for a profit after a period of time) dressed up as something more complicated, and over time we will see whether their shortcomings are revealed. The others are more interesting, however, and I will look forward to seeing how they pan out.

The initial review will last for 56 'Betting Days', with the option to extend to 84 'Betting Days' if necessary. This will all depend on how many games qualify for the systems and if I am able to draw a large enough conclusion from the results.

Important Announcement –

The Review Of Betting Tips UK

Brief Overview



On Sunday 25th September, which was Day 42 of the **Betting Tips UK** review, the betting bank used to place bets with went bust.

There were 40 tokens left to play with, but tokens are deducted when a winning bet is tipped – therefore, the amount outstanding was irrelevant as there was no betting bank to place the tips with in the first place.

Should You Have Carried Onto Day 56 Regardless?

The betting bank used (20 pts @ £25 per pt = £500) was recommended on the *Betting Tips UK* website...copy and pasted from the site today : "You can stake at £25 per bet with a £500 bank, and £50 per bet with a £1,000 bank. Generally your stake can be up to 5% as a maximum. So, if your bank was £400, your stake can be up to £20. Alternatively, if your bank was £2,000, your stake can be up to £100. The 5% level is considered to be safe and has worked throughout our history."

So having followed the advice given by Betting Tips UK, and wiped out the bank, I consider it appropriate to terminate the review early.

Any Other General Observations?

For the first forty days of the review, there were two different types of email received : 1) Selections and 2) Results update. The Results update

was a detailed synopsis and on how the bets had gone, the reasoning behind them and a look to the future. I found these quite informative and enjoyable to read. It was also quite handy as it gave the profit/loss figure for the day which I could check my figure against and prove that the profit/loss I was reporting was accurate.

However, from day 33 onwards, the detailed synopsis disappeared, and from Day 41, the results email disappeared altogether with not even an attempt at an explanation. The FAQ section on their website has been amended to say 'We no longer provide a results update'.

In addition, when I went on the Betting Tips UK site to have a look before starting my review, there was an interface to allow you to comment on the day's advice. I can't be specific as to when, but this has also disappeared, and I can find no information in my emails to explain this.

Whilst the above points aren't reasons alone to terminate the review early, it does seem to suggest a worrying downturn in what was an excellent customer service.

How Was The Bank Broken?

The review ran for 42 days. One of these was a no-bet day so we had 41 betting days. Of those 41 days, 27 of them returned a loss on the day, compared to 13 days that returned a profit (1 day returned 0 profit).

In terms of the cumulative (overall) profit/loss, we were in profit for 12 days, and running at a loss for 29 days.

Above is a table I have cobbled together (as I can't seem to master Excel charts/graphs, quite worryingly!).

The third column highlights the problem quite well. We went into Day 30 (13/09/2011) with our cumulative balance at +5.06 pts, which at £25 per point equated to £126.50 in profit.

However starting at Day 30 and going up Day 42 inclusive, of those 13 days, there was one day in profit of +2.32 pts and 12 days of losses totaling -27.59 pts for a net total over that period of -25.27 pts (equates to £631.75).

In the last 7 days alone, Days 36 to 42, there was a loss of -17.05 pts (-£426.05).

Betting Overview And Statistics

In the 41 betting days out of the 42 (one was a no bet day), the following occurred :

Total bets : 177

Winning bets : 63

Strike rate : 35.60 %

Average Odds : 2.50 (European), 6/4 (approx standard bookies odds)

The bets covered a range of sports including (but not limited to) snooker, football, darts, horse racing, tennis and cricket.

Summary

Having followed the advice given on the betting bank by Betting Tips UK and lost the lot, this review is terminated now.

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League Table of Current Reviews

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A reasonable way of comparing the performance of systems is to work out the profit (or loss) as a percentage of the starting bank. Obviously this table doesn't replace reading the reviews, because *profit as %age of bank* is not the only factor in judging a system. Nevertheless, it is a valid at-a-glance way of bringing the mass of data together.

I've colour coded the reviews that are the currently most successful, with the colour of their profitability graph to make them easier to spot.

This week, ExBookie has moved up to #2 and Assured Soccer Profits has moved up to #7. Sprint Lay Expert has had a bad couple of weeks. BetPlan and Beaten Females also slipped down the chart this week.

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Profitability Graph

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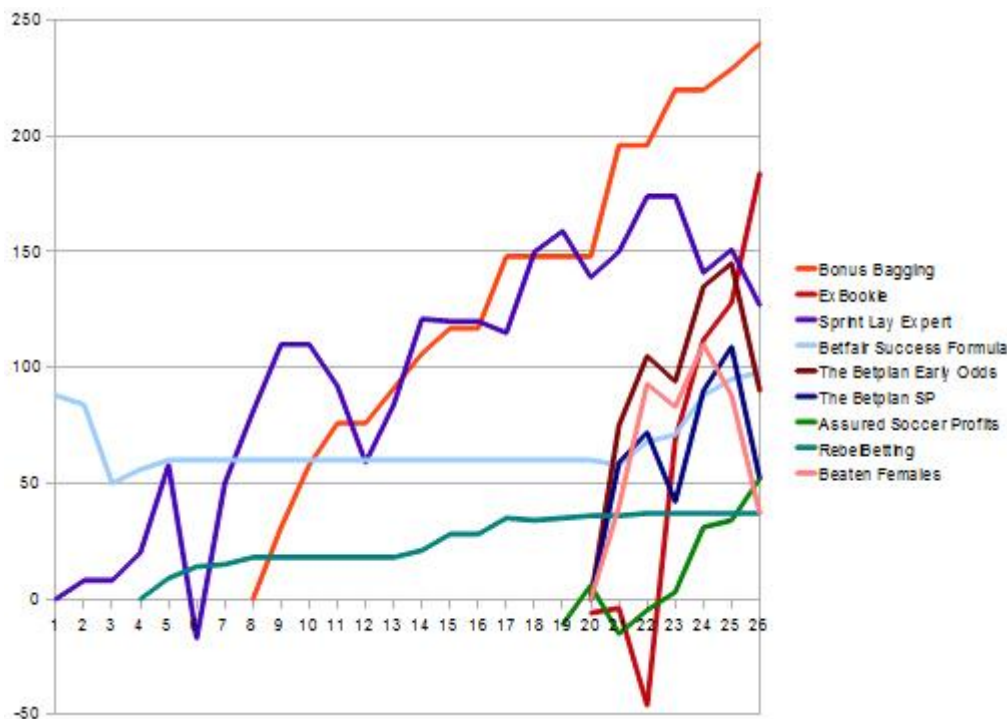


Here is a graph of the profit being made by the front-runners as a percentage of their starting bank. This gives a week by week comparative view of their progress.

It gives a representation of the volatility or dependability of each system. Ideally we would want a graph that increased each week by roughly the same amount. If a system or tipping service could produce that, then we would really have a winning review!

I'm only including those that are currently making over 20% profit. Bonus Bagging is far and away the best performing system during its review period. ExBookie has again increased its profit rapidly. Betfair Success Formula has done well since the start of this football season and Assured Soccer Profits continues in good form.

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Whip Crack Away!

How are the new whip-use rules affecting your punting?

The debate is raging over the new rules and at the time of writing this on Monday, we are waiting for the outcome of the meeting between the BHA and the jockeys and other interested parties.

Most aspects have been covered in the debate: horse welfare; difficulty of monitoring the number of cracks of the whip; pressure on jockeys to keep count and to know where the 1 furlong marker is situated; jockey suspensions and the withholding of jockey prize money.

But I haven't noticed too much debate about how the changes might affect punters. Wherever you stand on the horse welfare and new rules implementation debate, I wonder how much the new rules might affect results, maybe, especially place results?

Personally, I like watching a finish where jockeys are having to urge their steeds on with hands and heels. For me that shows true horsemanship and for me it is extremely exciting to watch, when two or three jockeys are riding full out for the finish.

But, how do the new rules affect finishing positions? Have any of you noticed a change in your punting success rate? In particular I am wondering how the rule change might alter place betting.

Anybody got any observations?
